

Remarks on Board the ship Washington

Sunday August the 31 in lat 62° 1' 29" N

The first part of these 24 hours light airs and cloudy the 2nd part moderate breeze and pleasant the latter part squally the same steering to the southward and eastward

Monday September the 1st lat 2° 10' N long 90° 30' W

The first part of these 24 hours commences with moderate breeze at 10 pm raised to a gale at 12 pm at 2 pm the boats are got two masts that made 20 barrels each

Tuesday Sept the 2nd The first part of these 24 hours commences with moderate breeze and squally the 2nd part the same all hands employed in cutting in the last part more sail and commencing boiling

Wednesday Sept the 3rd in lat 1° 8' N the first part of these 24 hours gentle gale the 2nd part finished boiling the last part some squally all hands employed in cleaning the churches

Thursday Sept the 4th in lat 1° 10' N the first part of these 24 hours light airs and pleasant raised to a gale at 10 pm and squally until dark but got more the 2nd part pleasant the last part gentle gale and squally

Friday Sept the 5th The first part of these 24 hours moderate breeze the 2nd part gentle gale and squally the 3rd part the same the 4th part light airs and pleasant the 5th part the same

Saturday Sept the 6th The first part of these 24 hours gentle gale and squally all hands employed in the ships duty

Sunday Sept the 7th in lat 2° 16' N long 90° 10' W At these these 24 hours different periods some quantities of rain and strong wind

Monday Sept the 8th The first part of these 24 hours light airs and cloudy the 2nd part the same the 3rd part stiff breeze some squally at 2 PM

Tuesday Sept the 9th All these 24 hours strong breeze and more weather at 10 PM a gale but no rain

Tuesday after leaving Charles Island
