

Remarks on board the ship Washington

Monday October the 14th lat 80° 30' long 88° 00' W
All these 24 hours light breeze and pleasant weather
all hands in place as to fore mentioned

Tuesday the 15th the first part of these 24 hours fine
weather still sailing the land part finished stowing the water
all hands clearing up and washing off

Wednesday the 16th the first part of these 24 hours
fine calm sailing under sail the water part the same
still in company with the same

Thursday the 17th the first part still stowing down
the water part finished stowing cleared up the decks and masts
the masts lowered as usual

Friday the 18th lat 80° 30' the first part of these
24 hours fresh breeze but in our top sail
sails the water part double and top sails and dander the
main sail

Saturday the 19th All these 24 hours
the sea fresh breeze with frequent squalls

Sunday the 20th all these 24 hours
fresh breeze the top sails double reefed steering
to the southward in company with the same

Monday the 21st All these 24 hours still
varying but we saw whales to windward but
could not fetch up to them

Tuesday the 22nd All these 24 hours
moderate breeze and pleasant weather
Wednesday the 23rd much the same

Thursday the 24th lat 80° 25' W
the first part of these 24 hours pleasant sailing
off the land under the water but did not get on

Friday the 25th All these 24 hours light breeze
and pleasant weather saw whales to windward

Saturday the 26th All these 24 hours light breeze
rising when on the way low down the water the
sailors could not get fast saw 70 whales in the
line parted and we lost him

Sunday the 27th All these 24 hours light breeze
and moderate this day our speed was rapid
saw steaming round about the others and threatening
to jump over bore

the rest of period in October 1833

Monday the 28th All these 24 hours pleasant weather
all hands in place in mending sails

Tuesday the 29th All these 24 hours we had
fresh breeze we could not reef the top sails
we lost one main sail and bent one out

Wednesday the 30th All these 24 hours more moderate
the business in the ship is over

Thursday the 31st lat 80° 30' long 90° 00' W
All these 24 hours fresh breeze and squally at 8 AM
we lowered the boats fore a whale but we got none

Friday November the first All these 24 hours
more moderate but cloudy with some rain

Saturday the 2nd lat 80° 30' W the first part of
these 24 hours we had fresh breeze and squally weather
the 2nd part much the same the last part very squally
we doubled reefed the top sails, mended the main sail

Sunday the 3rd lat 80° 30' W long 90° 00' W
the first part of these 24 hours we had fresh breeze and
cloudy weather the 2nd part much the same we saw numbers
of fin backs the water part very rough and rainy

Monday the 4th All these 24 hours more moderate but
cloudy squally the water part and set the top gallant sails
stowing them with the wind aft

Tuesday the 5th All these 24 hours fresh breeze
much pleasant weather saw a school of fin backs

Wednesday the 6th All these 24 hours fresh breeze
and cloudy weather

Thursday the 7th lat 80° 30' W long 90° 00' W
All these 24 hours light breeze and pleasant weather
we struck out the scales and set the main sail flying
top and main top gallant sails steering East by N

Friday the 8th All these 24 hours light breeze
and pleasant weather now ship E by N

Saturday the 9th lat 80° 30' W all these 24 hours
light breeze and pleasant weather standing in for land

Sunday the 10th All these 24 hours much the same
saw a school of black fish moving at 12 & 2
