

Remarks on board of the ship Washington
 Sunday the 19th lat 60 40 S long 83 30
 All these 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant
 weather (Monday Jan the 20th)
 All these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather
 raised a white stockade powder in the boats and
 the waist boat got one that made 30 lbs
 Tuesday the 21st All these 24 hours fresh breezes
 All hands imployed in trying out lat 60 30 S
 Wednesday the 22nd All these 24 hours moderate breezes
 and cloudy weather saw a number of black fish
 Thursday the 23rd lat 70 40 S
 All these 24 hours fresh breezes and sent the main top
 sail to mend it and sent it again
 Friday the 24th lat 70 43 S
 The first part of these 24 hours fresh breezes and pleasant
 weather the 2nd part showed young 50 lbs of oil
 the last part saw a ship off the lee bow tacklet ship
 to the southward
 Saturday the 25th lat 70 44 S
 All these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather
 Sunday the 26th lat 80 S
 The first part pleasant and moderate breezes the latter part
 much the same spoke ship sight of new land 100 fathoms
 seven months out 200 lbs standing to the eastward
 Monday Jan the 27th lat 70 30 S long 87 30 W
 All these 24 hours pleasant weather
 and moderate breezes tacklet ship to the eastward
 Tuesday the 28th lat 70 30 S
 The first part of these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant
 weather a school of black fish to the forward lower the starboard
 boat from that got none the latter part tacklet ship
 to the southward saw the ship with heading to the eastward
 Wednesday the 29th all these 24 hours
 light breezes and pleasant weather the main sail
 mended it and sent it again
 Thursday the 30th lat 70 S long 88 00
 all these 24 hours pleasant weather heading to the east
 Friday the 31st all these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant
 weather the waist boat and got out another heading to the east

After leaving Charles island on a course
 Saturday the 1st lat 80 40 S
 All these 24 hours light breezes and cloudy weather
 Sunday the 2nd lat 70 40 S long 88 19 W
 All these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant at 12 o'clock
 the water discovered heading for land at 10 o'clock
 Monday the 3rd all these 24 hours light breezes
 and pleasant weather tacklet ship to the southward saw a
 large school of black fish lower the 2 forward boats
 and killed one at 10 pm saw a ship and stood to
 Tuesday the 4th lat 80 40 S long 88 19 W
 All these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather
 to the southward
 Wednesday the 5th All these 24 hours
 moderate breezes and pleasant weather the 2 forward boats
 and got a large black fish at 12 in the evening tacklet ship
 Thursday the 6th all these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant
 weather all hands imployed in various jobs in the ship
 Friday the 7th lat 70 30 S long 88 19 W
 All these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather
 the main land at 2 o'clock in the morning heading
 east 20 leagues tacklet ship and stood to the southward
 Saturday the 8th lat 80 40 S
 All these 24 hours pleasant weather continued making
 short land to the southward and eastward
 Sunday the 9th lat 90 10 S all these 24 hours
 light breezes and pleasant heading to the east
 Monday the 10th lat 80 40 S All the first part
 the latter part much the same heading to the east
 Tuesday the 11th lat 80 40 S the first part
 moderate breezes at 2 o'clock pm came to anchor in
 7 fathoms of water the captain went on shore he returned
 very shortly with several of the inhabitants
 Wednesday the 12th all these 24 hours pleasant
 weather the captain went on shore with the captain of a Spanish ship
 Thursday the 13th all these 24 hours pleasant
 weather the harbor watch had liberty to go on shore
 with 3 of us went on shore on Tuesday
 one of the natives of the place to give the natives that
 were of dried with them we saw several of ground
 covered with human remains
