

Remarks on board the ship

Sunday the 24th the first part of the day light winds and squally the day after the captain went on shore for coals with the other part of the crew with 800 lbs of fat at 12 at night 2 men run away from the ritch man by swimming ashore

Monday the 25th these 24 hours commences with light winds and rain the 2 captains went on shore to find the men but without success the 1st part of the ship got underway and stood out in company with the other 2 parts on board

Tuesday the 26th all these 24 hours fresh gales and rain at 12 at night the ritch men and part of company and stood to the southward

From August the 24 to September the first worthy notice sept the first lot of 2 sperm whale a head lower the boats and got 2 by the starboard and waist boats but them in one hour fore and

Tuesday sept the 2nd the first part light winds and cloudy the day after got 2 sperm whale by the fore and waist boats and them in the same day

Wednesday the 3rd all these 24 hours light winds and pleasant all hands employed in boiling salt beef

Thursday the 4th all these 24 hours all hands employed in drying the 2nd match the same finished drying at dark

Friday sept the 5th the first part fresh breezes and squally the 2nd part stormy down by dark

Sunday the 7th all these 24 hours fresh breezes and squally spoke ship messenger of new Bedford 26 months out at 12 10 lbs

Monday the 8th all these 24 hours fresh breezes and squally starting for Charles is and

Tuesday sept the 9th nothing more happened more than to the northward

Wednesday sept the 10th the same wind and saw large numbers of porpoises

Thursday sept the 11th with all these 24 hours light winds and rain the 1st part of the ship got underway

Friday sept the 12th with all these 24 hours light winds and rain the 2nd part of the ship got underway
