 Lat 31-52 Long 26-30
 Oct Commences with Light breeze and
 first pleasant weather middle & latter
 1851 part the same saw the Island
 of Palma Ferro Gomezo Terrefe this
 end Land Dist 15 miles this end
 this day with no oil yet
 Friday Oct 3d Forepart strong breeze & squally middle
 1851 & latter part the same saw 5 sails
 but no whale they end strong
 W by W
 Lat 28-39 North
