the 1st head to the S E all sail out
1851 Middle & latter part the same
Lat 8.20 Long 30.00

Sun Forepart Brisk breeze from the S E
Nov 25 Middle & latter part the same the Eng
1851 Lat 10.45 South
Mon Forepart Light breeze from the East head
30 S W all sail out Middle & latter part
1851 the same Lat 13.08 South

Tues Forepart Light breeze and squally from
the Eastward steering S E by W all sail
4th out Middle & latter part the same
1851 they Ency caught a porpoise
Lat 14.33 South
