Took to the Eastward they ended

Feb. 21 Forepart - 6 Light Breezy and pleasant
1851 at 11 AM saw 1 rt. Whale going
quick to the S E Lowered 2 Boats
With out success at 1 PM came on Board
and at 6 PM saw 3 rt. Whales Lowered
and chased them un-till 9 came on
Board took in sail for the Night Land
bearing W by S Dist. homely they
and had Luck
