 20th Fore Top Mast Stay Sail & Main Spencer
 at day Light kept her away North under
 Clost reef Top sail & Fore sail thus Ends
 S E. Lat 25 19 Long 41.00

Sabbath Forepart strong gales and cloudy steering
 21st N N W under Doubled reef Top sail
 Middle & Latter part the same
 thus Ends S E Lat 23 12 Long 40.68

Monday Forepart strong gales and cloudy
 22d steering N N W Wind S E Middle
 1852 and Latter part more moderate
 steering N W & W N W at 2 o'clock
 saw the Island of Passad de India
 at sundown the Land dist 5 miles
 bearing W by N tacked off shore
 and took in sail for the Night

33 Mozambique Channel, C. Downs

Tues Forepart Light breezes and calms Middle & Latter
 23d the same Land dist 12 miles bearing W N W
 tried the the current found it setting
 E S E at the rate of 1/2 miles per hour

Wed Forepart Light breezes and pleasant
 24th at Day Light saw the Land dist 3 miles
 and the Boat on shore Middle the
 same the Boat still on shore Latter
 part squally and calm the Boat
 on shore still Lat 22.22 Long 40.25

Thurs Forepart Light breezes and calms and
 25th squally Middle part strong gales at 11
 the Boat came on board she got 2 green turtles
 Latter part Lying To under clost reef
 Main Top sail blowing heavy from S E
 Head S W by W Lat 22 22 Long 40.10

Friday Forepart strong gales and squally Lying
 26 To under clost reef Main Top sail at
 1852 Day Light at the Foresail reef Middle part
 at the first Latter part strong gales Lying
 To thus Ends No Obey this Day
