 21st Light Breezes and pleasant all these 24 hours
 22nd Head S. S. W. very sick Lat 26.53 Long 41.25
 23rd all these 24 hours
 May 1st Fore part Light Windy and passing
 cloudy L B first Watch
 I have got the consumption Lat 24.30 Long 43.10
 May 4th Fore part Light Breezes and fine weather
 1852 at 1 P M saw  Sp Whales
 first 5 miles off 8 mine 5=30 minutes
 lower 2 1/2 but it was so late did not
 strike thus End that day
 Lat 24 19 Long 48.01
 May 8th Fore part Strong Breezes and and pass
 1852 cloudy  Middle & latter part the
 same at sun Antvown saw sp Whales
 going to the leward to late to lower
 Lat 24 25 Long 47.56
