 Gale from the N W steering
 O P North on close reefed Top
 sail & Fore sail
 at Dark stood half Wateky
 O if I was at home to Night
 if I had nothing but herrings
 and Gony cake and cold
 Water it would be better
 than Waling Lat 27 21 Long 51.20
