Begins with fine weather the watch at work as different jobs in the rigging Middle & latter part fine the watch employed in breaking out the after hold for medd. steering S W by S

Wednesday 9th

Begins with fine weather steering S W by S the watch at work in the after hold breaking out and storing it off again Middle part fine the wind shifted round to the N W took in studding sails and braced up Latter part steering S W by the wind saw 4 sail.

Thursday 10th

Begins with fine weather the watch employed in various jobs Middle & Latter part a light breeze saw 8 sail the watch employed in various jobs

Lat 32.05 S long 48.51 W

Friday 11th

Begins with a light breeze saw 1 sail the watch employed in mending the fly gill Middle part a strong breeze steering S W by S Latter part fine weather the watch employed in mending the Gill saw 2 sail. Lat 34.01 S long 49.43 W

Saturday 12th

Begins with a light breeze steering S W by S the watch employed mending the gill saw 1 sail Middle part a strong breeze steering S W by S Latter part a light breeze 2 sail in sight of hammer with the Cherokee of N B. Slaughtered a turtle

Lat 35.10 S long 52.14 W

Sunday 13th

Begins with a strong breeze from the S E steering S W by S saw 4 sperm whales bound to the windward saw 4 sail Middle & latter part a light breeze lowered for black fish but got none Lat 37.02 S long 52.38 W

Monday Jan 14th

Begins with a fine breeze steering S W by S fair wind Middle part the same Latter part a strong breeze from the S E steering S W by S the watch employed in mending the foresail

Lat 39.64 S long 54.06 W

Tuesday 15th

Begins with a strong breeze from the S W steering S W by S finished the foresail and sent it Middle part a strong breeze steering S W by S with thunder and lightning Latter part thick rainy weather

Wednesday 16th

Begins with thick rainy weather steering S W by S at 12 o'clock a sudden shift of wind came out but was first took in sail down to double reefed topsails and furled mainsail split the gill at 4 o'clock made all sail again standing to the S by the wind Middle part a strong breeze steering S W by S Latter part a fine breeze steering S W by S sent in the Gill repaired it and sent it again sent down the Mr. Fitzgerald sail and repaired it

Lat 42.14 S long 56.14 W

Thursday 17th

This day begins with a fine breeze steering S W by S finished the Mr. Fitzgerald sail and sent it again Middle part a strong breeze from the S W Latter part a strong breeze took in topgallant sails heaving to the S E

Lat 44.00 S long 54.06 W

Friday 18th

Came with blowing a strong breeze from the S at 4 o'clock word ship heading to the W B Middle part the wind shifted round to the S E blowing a strong breeze and rainy steering S W by S Latter part a fine breeze steering S W by S
