

Saturday Jan 19th

This day begins with light winds and heavy steering by the wind S W by E caught a porpoise Middle part light winds thick and rainy latter part a strong breeze and squally from the S E

Sunday 20

Begins with fine weather made all sail ahead wind Middle part a light breeze at 4 P M took in all sail except double reefed foresail sharp lightning and very heavy thunder at 6 P M made all sail again light wind saw Chinooks.

Monday 21st

Begins with a fine breeze saw Chinooks at 12 P M took ship and headed to the S E E caught a porpoise at 5 P M took ship and headed W squally latter Middle part squally heading from W by N to W by N latter part fine breeze steering S W by E.

Tuesday 22nd

Begins with fine weather and a fine breeze steering S W by E latter part a strong breeze steering R

Wednesday 23rd

This day begins with a light breeze steering S saw a right whale Middle & latter part a fine breeze steering S saw a star

Lat 49 48 Long 63 40 W

Thursday 24th

Begins with a fine breeze steering S the wind from W Middle part squally at 8 P M had heavy squall took in all the light sail & furled the fore and mizen top sails & gill at 10 P M made sail again at 1 P M took in again blowing strong from the W Middle part a strong breeze from the W steering S by E.

Lat 51 18 Long 62 05 W

Friday Jan 25th

This day begins with a strong breeze steering S by E at 5 P M set while maintopail and single reefed fore Main top gallantail & M. Gill latter part a strong breeze and fine weather latter part a fine breeze steering S the old land in sight

Lat 53 30 Long 62 08 W

Saturday 26th

Begins a fine breeze steering S Middle part a fine breeze the wind hauled round to the S E steering at Daylight saw Statenland leaving of Lutan's about 80 Miles hauled up S E latter a strong breeze steering S E latter thick fog & rainy steering S E

Sunday 27th

Begins with a thick fog and rainy steering S W the wind from the S Middle part the same at 11 P M the wind hauled to the S W in a squall furled foresail and mizen mainsail and gill latter part steering to under blue reefed maintopail and fore spinnaker.

Monday 28th

Begins with blowing a gale from the S W still a laying to saw a sail Middle & latter part the same blowing a gale still a laying to heading to the S E

Tuesday 29th

This day begins with blowing a gale more ship headed to the S E W saw a sail at 6 P M wind back again heading to the S E Middle & latter part still blowing a gale saw a sail set reefed foresail.

Wednesday 30th

Begins with better weather more moderate while spinnaker gill & fore and reefed mainsail latter part a fine breeze steering S W latter blowing heavy from the S steering to the W under double reefed topsail mainsail and whole fore sail Lat 52 22
