

Saturday Feb. 9th 1856

Commenced with a strong breeze made and took in sail Middle a strong breeze heading to the N.E. & W. By the wind latter part a fine breeze set top gallant sail took in foretop gallant sail and fly gills were ship headed to the N.E. & W. Lat 54.52 Long 75.43 W

Sunday 10th

Begins with a strong breeze took in sail double reefed topsails furled the main topmast Mainmast and full heading N.W. by Wind at 6 P.M. close reefed foretop sail furled the fore sail Middle part blowing a strong breeze heading N.W. by N latter part foggy weather at 8 P.M. were ship and headed to the N.E. & W. took out the reef set Main top gallant sail a fly gill.

Monday 11th

Begins with a fine breeze heading to the N.E. & W. foggy saw a sail Middle part a fine breeze and foggy at 9 P.M. were ship and headed to the N.E. & W. at 6 A.M. tacked ship and headed to the N.E. & W. Latter part thick foggy weather parted the fly gill Mainmast.

Tuesday 12th

Begins with thick foggy weather a light breeze all put out heading N.W. by the wind Middle part calm a thick fog Latter part a fine breeze from the S.E. steering N.W. by N and sails.

Wednesday 13th

Begins with a fine breeze from the S.E. and fine weather steering N.W. by N and 1 sail Middle part a light breeze steering N.W. by N Mainmast standing sail out Latter part a light breeze and fine weather steering N.W. by N

Lat 52.11 Long 79.43 W

Thursday 14th Feb

This Day begins with fine weather the wind from the S.E. steering N.W. by N lowered the boats to practice the crew in pulling Middle part a light breeze steering N.W. by N saw Blackbird Latter part a light breeze heading to the S.E. at 12 P.M. tacked ship a headed to the S.E. & W.

Lat 51.30 S

Friday 15th

Commenced with a fine breeze heading to the S.E. & W. Middle part a strong breeze took in top gallant sail fly gill a reefed Fore & Main top sails at 3 P.M. whole Mainmast and Main top gallant sail heading to the S.E. Latter part a strong breeze heading to the S.E. at 12 P.M. were ship headed to the S.E.

Lat 50.25 Long 78.43 W

Saturday 16th

Begins with a strong breeze heading to the S.E. & W. at 6 P.M. double reefed the topsails Middle part blowing strong furled the Fore & Main topsails a gill at 10 P.M. were ship a headed to the S.E. Latter part a fine breeze all sail out steering N.W. by N the wind from the N.E.

Lat 49.41 Long 78.28 W

Sunday 17th

Commenced with a fine breeze from the N.W. steering N.W. by N caught a Porpoise Middle part the wind the same Latter part a fine breeze heading N.W. by N The wind from N.E. Lat 47.02 Long 78.0 W

Monday 18th

Begins with a fine breeze heading from N.W. by N to N.W. Middle part a light breeze heading N.W. by N the wind Latter part a fine breeze steering N.W. by N saw thousands of Porpoises
