

Tuesday Feb 19th

Begins with a fine breeze steering N.W. by N. and spun Whales and Lancers for them but without success ran a sail Middle part a light breeze and passing Sandy steering N.W. by W. Latter part a strong breeze heading to the S.W.

Wednesday 20th

Begins with a strong breeze heading to the S.W. by S. the wind from the W. took in fore and Mizzen topgallant sails Middle part blowing strong took in by full at 10 P.M. tacked ship heading off by S. the wind hauled round to the S.W. at 2 P.M. the hauled round to the S. and caught us aback squared the yards & steered N. rain set topmast studding sail.

Lat 41.55 S Long 75.25 W

Thursday 21st

Begins with blowing strong from the S. steering N. Middle part a fine breeze with squalls of rain took in studding sail steering N. Latter part a fine breeze steering N.

Lat 39.19 S Long 74.40 W

Friday 22nd

Begins with a fine breeze steering N. at 2 P.M. saw the Island of La La Mocha bearing N.W. by W. distant about 30 miles hauled up for it at sundown it bore N. distant about 8 miles took in the light sails and furled the Main sail Middle part laying off to the windward of the Island at 2 P.M. faced forward and run down to the landing at 3 P.M. the boat went ashore to get potatoes at 4 P.M. let go the anchor getting off potatoes.

Saturday Feb 23rd

Begins with fine weather and a strong breeze getting off potatoes got one half of a buff at 3 P.M. hauled anchor and got underway steering N.W. Middle & Latter part a fine breeze steering N.W. with studding sails out.

Sunday 24th

Begins with a fine breeze steering N.W. by N. all sail out Middle & Latter part the same.

Monday 25th

Begins with a fine breeze steering N.W. by N. all sail out Middle & Latter part the same.

Tuesday 26th

Begins with a fine breeze steering N.W. by N. all sail out the watch employed in various jobs of ships duty Middle & Latter part the same.

Wednesday 27th

Begins with a fine breeze steering N.W. by N. with all sail out spoke the schooner teracenta of Palparao Middle & Latter part the same.

Thursday 28th

Begins with a fine breeze steering N.W. by N. the watch employed in various jobs of ships duty Middle & Latter part a fine breeze saw the ~~Island~~ of St. Felix & steered for it.

Friday 29th

Begins with a strong breeze the 3 barboard boats went in fishing at dark returned with a good lot of fish Middle all sail and steered N.W. by N. Middle & Latter part the same.
