

Sunday May 4th 1856

Begins with a strong breeze from the S^W steering N^W by N Middle & latter a strong breeze steering N^W by N with a rain.

Lat 37.00 N Long 151.00 W

Monday 5th

This day begins with a strong breeze steering N^W by N with a rain at 4 AM the wind hauls round to the S^W & B^W still thick & rainy. Middle & latter part the same the light sail in.

Tuesday 6th

Begins with thick rainy weather steering N^W the wind hauls more to the S^W blowing a strong gale at 10 AM took in the light sail by 5 PM. At 6 AM doubled reefed the topsails blowing a gale middle part blowing a gale the wind to the N^W thick and rainy at 8 AM furled the fore & main topsails gill and hove her to heading to the N^W by N latter part foggy at 11 AM lighted up set the fore & main topsails heading N^W by N

Lat 45.04 N Long 153.28 E

Wednesday 7th

Begins more moderate set Main sail and whole topsails heading N^W by N and fine weather saw Chimneys Middle part thick latter part fine weather made all sail steering N^W by N of the wind at 8 PM at 10 AM saw Marican ~~_____~~ Bearing N^W by N

Thursday May 8th 1856

Begins with a slight breeze steering for the Kuroko Straits N^W by N at sundown Marican ~~_____~~ bore N^W by N distant about 20 miles and Company ~~_____~~ N^W by N about 20 miles distant.

Middle part a light breeze steering N^W by N latter part a strong breeze from the S^W steering N^W by the wind few Chimneys & light sprinkling of snow. Lat 41.37 N Long 151.18 E

Friday 9th

Begins with thick foggy weather blowing strong heading N^W by N of the wind at 10 AM took in the Royals and J. Topgallant sail Mizzen and Main of gill

The land in sight. Middle part blowing strong set topgallant sail at 10 AM took in Royal topsails double reefed topsails at 11 AM took in gill fore & main topsails Main sail and furled them ~~_____~~ at 12 set fore Mizzen topsails and gill a few snow balls

Lat 49.12 N Long 152.57 E

Saturday 10th

Begins with blowing a gale heading N^W by N at 4 PM took in gill & blue reefed topsails a heavy sea on Middle part moderate at 2 AM took in ship heading to the N^W and made sail latter part a thick snow storm.

Sunday 11th

Begins with a snow storm and a light breeze from the S^W steering N^W at 4 PM took in sail Middle part a light breeze from the S^W & B^W latter part a light breeze steering to the N^W.
