Begins with a fine steering N.W. a small sprinkling of snow Middle part calm latter part a fine breeze steering N.W. by the wind

Monday 19th

Begins with a fine breeze steering N.W. by the wind it being from the S.E. saw a plenty of ice and 3 ships at 5 P.M. kept off to the N.W. and rounded along side of the ice spoke the Crossack of N.B. saw 8 ships 2 a feeling saw a Brother S. Middle and latter part backing & coming the ice spoke the Alice Mendell of N.B. a boiling

Tuesday 20th

Begins with a strong breeze standing off and on the ice & ships in sight 3 a boiling Middle & latter a light breeze sculling round the ice gaining with the Alice Mendell several ships in sight 3 a boiling

Wednesday 21st

Begins with a light breeze still a gaining with the Alice Middle part a strong breeze spoke the Levi Starbuck latter part a light breeze lowered for what is had got more ships a feeling from the Alice Mendell
