

Saturday May 31st

Begins with a thick fog heading S. & E. laying a back of 4th brace forward scattering ice still a boiling middle part a boiling finished latter part blowed for got none.

Sunday June 1st

Begins with fine breeze for whales but got none middle and latter part a strong downy S. at 9 A.M. finished staving down.

Monday 2nd

Begins with fine weather lowered for whales the W.B. got one at 2 P.M. began to cut at 8 finished middle part the watches a clearing up the decks latter part at 3 P.M. began to boil



Tuesday 3rd

Begins with a strong breeze still a boiling scattering and plenty of snow lowered 3 boats for but got none middle and latter part blowing strong from S.W. said a ship and a plenty of whales all bound to the windward into the heavy ice still a boiling

Wednesday 4th

Begins with a strong breeze sculling about the ice at 10 P.M. finished boiling latter part a breaking getting ready to blow down at 11 A.M. began to run down oil saw 2 ships and a few whales

Thursday June 5th

Begins with a strong breeze and foggy spoke the Omega of S.H. at 6 P.M. finished staving down middle a latter part a thick fog hailed the Omega as she passed us saw no whales

Friday 6th

Begins with a strong breeze running around in the ice spoke the Chandler Price of S.H. middle part calm latter part a fine breeze lowered the boats for whales but without success.

Saturday 7th

Begins with a light breeze and foggy gamed with the Omega of S.H. no whales in sight but a plenty of scattering ice middle part a light breeze latter part a clear part of the time and foggy part the boat went into the ice to look for whales but saw nothing

Sunday 8th

Begins with blowing strong thick foggy weather middle a latter part foggy rain weather blowing from the S.E. cleared of ice once more double reefed topsails took in gills & sprays

Monday 9th

Begins with blowing a gale with rainy foggy weather middle part the same fresh from a heavy topsails at 4 P.M. wore ship and headed S.W. in shore latter part more moderate made sail
