Sunday 15th June

Begins with a strong breeze still a boiling a plenty of ice in sight Middle & latter part the same.

Monday 16th

Begins with fine weather at 10 A.M. finished boiling began to fresh out and getting ready to start the oil of middle part. a light breeze latter steering strong still a steering down.

Tuesday 17th

Begins with fine weather a steering down the oil Middle part fine weather latter part fine finished steering down.

Wednesday 18th

Begins with a light breeze looking out shores and ships head of ships Middle & latter fine still looking for the shore head back and found must.

Thursday 19th

Begins with fine weather got out the shore heads and ships and stored off again steering in and around the ice Middle part the same latter part the boats went into the ice but said nothing game with the force of Stonington.

Friday 20th

Begins with a fine breeze steering to the W. Middle & latter part the same game with the Eugene.
