Begins with a light breeze steering to the W in towards the land the breeze putting up shoals still a jamming with the Eugene Middle part calm the Capt of the ship 12 came on board at 4 AM the Capt left and went on board latter part a light breeze employed in weighing some the copper at work on the shoals.

Sunday 22nd

Begins with a light breeze and foggy, gamed with the Franklin of 16 Middle part the same latter thick and foggy blowing strong southerly raised the topsail and the Lone

Monday 23rd

Begins with thick foggy weather saw the land several ships Middle a latter the same blowing strong from the N E standing off land and the land

Tuesday 24th

Begins thick foggy wet disagreeable weather standing off and on the land blowing strong Middle and latter part the same gamed with the Eugene of 16

Wednesday 25th

Begins with heavy snow and foggy still a jamming with the Eugene used a dead whale lowered the boat and took skin along side that broke up the jamming Middle part surged up the topsail and fished off shore latter part calms cut in the whale.

Thursday June 26th

Begins with a calm and foggy began to sail saw the land at the top sail Middle part a light breeze still a boiling latter part blowing strong still a boiling and in night latter a fine breeze and foggy still a boiling

Friday 27th

Begins with a light breeze still a boiling rain wet weather Middle a latter part the same finished boiling

Saturday 28th

Begins with thick foggy weather Middle a latter part the same at 4 AM began to get ready for stowing down at 8 began to stow down the m/s.

Sunday 29th

Begins with a strong breeze all hands at work a stowing down gamed with the Chandler twice of 16 at 8 PM finished stowing down

Monday 30th

Begins with a strong breeze from the N E with thick foggy weather Middle and latter part the same a blowing a gale of wind

Tuesday July 1st

Begins with blowing a heavy gale of wind Middle part the same thick and foggy at 2 PM carried away the fore boat latter part blowing a gale thick and foggy
