

Wednesday July 2nd

Begins more moderate but thick & rainy. Middle part set whale to head with a sharper thick foggy and rainy. Starboard boat went out to a whale and missed him at 11 P.M. the boats came on board. Latter part a light breeze sent 8 boats in shore for Whales.

Thursday July 3rd

Begins with light breeze the boats of after whale. Middle part a fresh breeze at the boats came on board at 11 came to anchor in 12 fathoms of water. Latter part light breeze and shaver sent Starboard and West boats went in shore for whale. Starboard & East boats went in shore for Water.

Friday 4th

First part of this 24 hours a heavy tempest with stones as big as apples at 4 the boats returned with the water the Capt. of the India and Ontario came on board. Middle part calm the other boats returned and the Starboard chain got the anchor of the East at 10 set the watch at 4 P.M. the L.B. & W. boats started for Southwest Bay.

Latter part stowing down oil & water down the fore holds.

Saturday 5th

This 24 hours thick fog at 5 P.M. a heavy tempest. Middle part cleared off. Latter part a thick fog the boats down the Bay.

Sunday July 6th

First part of this 24 hours light air at 5 P.M. got underway. Middle and latter part fine weather came to 20 fathoms of water the boats still down the Bay.

Monday 7th

First part of this 24 hours light air from S.W. at 8 P.M. a strong breeze from N.E. at 2 P.M. got underway bound to S.W. Bay. At 6 o'clock reefed topsails employed in sailing home at 9 P.M. set the watch at 10 P.M. set the watch spoke the ship Ontario. Middle part moderate came to anchor in 15 fathoms of water at 4 P.M. L.B. West & East boats went up the bay to look for fish. Latter part a strong breeze and thick fog.

Mistake Tuesday 8th Monday 9th

This day begins with a fresh breeze and thick fog the Capt. of the bark Canton Packet came on board. Middle part the same at 1 P.M. the Sea came down upon us. Latter part at 8 P.M. got underway and stood off shore the Capt. of the Omega came on board.

Tuesday 8th

This 24 hours begins with a fresh breeze. Middle part the same sent down the Royal guards. Latter part the same the boats returned.

Wednesday 10th

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze and thick fog at 2 P.M. came to an anchor about 8 miles of shore in 20 fathoms of water. Middle & latter part light air and thick fog and a number of whales and lowered but with no success.
