

Sunday July 20th S. West Bay

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze lowered the barboard and Bow boats and went up the bay for whales saw a number but could not strike Middle part got underway at 10 came to anchor again at 11 P.M. the boats came on board. Latter part rainy with disagreeable weather.

Wednesday 21st

First part of this 24 hours a strong from N.E. and rainy Middle part moderate at 3 P.M. lowered all 4 boats and went up the bay Latter part thick and foggy by spells

Thursday 22nd

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from N.E. and thick weather Middle part a very heavy tempest it lasted about 4 hours. Latter part moderate but thick the boats still away.

Friday 23rd

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather at 4 P.M. the S and S boat returned they saw a number of whale but they were wild Middle part the same at 7 P.M. the Mast and Bow Boat came on board at 4 got underway at 6 lowered all the boats for whales Latter part calm at 8 came to anchor in 8 fathoms of water.

Thursday 24th

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze at 1 P.M. got underway and at 4 came to anchor again in 1/2 fath of water at 7 P.M. the boats returned Middle the same at 8 got underway Latter part a light breeze from N.E. and fine weather Capt Dennis came on board, and so ends this 24 hours

Friday July 25th

First part of this 24 hours light air from N.E. at 10 A.M. came to anchor in 18 fath of water in company of the Harrier and Alice Mandell. the Capt of the Alice came on board and told us our boat that we had about 4 weeks before she had a Lap ago on the beach about 2 P.M. off at 2 P.M. the Bow Boat started in pursuit of the last boat at 5 P.M. got underway working through heavy ice towards Shantow Bay in company with the Alice and the Harrier Middle part the same at 11 came to anchor in 13 fath of water at 4 the S boat and S boat started for Shantow Bay latter part got underway at 8 P.M. came to anchor in Horse shoes Bay in 10 fathoms of water the quarter boat up Shantow Bay and the Bow boat still in search of the last boat.

Saturday 26th

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze from N.E. at 3 P.M. got underway and stood out of the bay the ice coming down upon us to stand

Middle part the same got underway at 8 P.M. came to anchor under Eagle Point in 10 fathoms of water Latter part the same the boats still away.

Sunday 27th

First part of this 24 hours light air from N.E. the Mast boat in shore for wood Middle latter the same the boats still off.

Monday 28th

This 24 hours begins with light air from N.E. Middle latter the same the boats still away
