

Tuesday Monday July 29th

First part of this 24 hours light breeze from N.E. the boat returned with the news that the boat was on board the Delaware Middle part thick and foggy Latter part the same went on board of the Delaware and got the boat the quarters boat still up the Bay

Wednesday 30th

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze from the N.E. Middle part calm Latter part the same the boats still off up the Bay

Thursday Aug 1st

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze Middle part the same the boats came on board after getting a whale and towing him 3 days and lost him in the ice Latter part the same got underway and dropped down a piece and let go the Anchor again in 8 fathoms of water

Friday 2nd

First part of this 24 hours at 10th and at 5 P.M. lowered away the quarters and boat boats They went up the bay after whale Middle part calm and foggy ice coming down heavy

Saturday 3rd

First part of this 24 hours a strong breeze from E.S.E. Middle part calm & foggy boats still away

Sunday 4th

First part of this 24 hours fine weather got underway and went up the bay spoke the Galia at 9 o'clock let go the anchor again in 9 fathoms of water and heavy ice around us Middle part Latter part rain at 8 P.M. took the anchor and stood up the bay

Monday Aug 5th 1886

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze from the E. at 12 o'clock took the anchor and stood up the Bay at 1 o'clock fog with a sprinkling of rain at 5 P.M. let go the anchor in 9 fathoms of water Middle part a strong breeze from N.W. at 4 o'clock called all hands and furled the sails Latter part the same at 9 o'clock took the anchor and stood up the Bay the boats still away

Tuesday 6th

First part of this 24 hours a fresh breeze from N.E. at 2 P.M. came to anchor in the East shore in 6 fathoms of water at 11 P.M. the 2 Quarters boats came on board Middle part the same the Alice Mandell stopped on board of us all night Latter part fine the L.M. Harst went a clamming shipped one Boatsteerer and Foremast hand from the ship Tangumack which is wrecked at 10 o'clock the Bird boat came on board

Wednesday 7th

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze from the S.W. The Capt and Carpenter repairing the Starboard and Bow boats Middle part the same Laid out and wait boats came on board Latter part fine lowered the Star & Mast boats the went up to the Eastern point found it full of ice and plenty of whales but no chance to get at them

Thursday 8th

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze from the S.E. at 7 o'clock the boats came on board still at work mending the boats Middle part a heavy tempest it lasted about 5 hours Latter part fine weather the wind S.W. sent off the Starboard and Mast boats
