Monday 10th

heard quite a number of whales through the
night Middle and latter part fine weather
the Mast and lower Boats came on board
saw a plenty of whales the Mast struck 1 and
draved from him, the shipkeepers employed in
steering down oil in the after hold.

Tuesday 11th

First part of this 24 hours not raining
weather at 8 A.M. lowered away the Boat for
for Whales Middle and latter part thick
cloudy weather Capt Andrews of Bark junior
and stopped a short time at 6 P.M. the Boats
returned again saw a some few whales.

Wednesday 12th

First part of this 24 hours a fresh breeze
from the E. at 8 A.M. lowered away 3 Boats to go
up the Bay. Middle & latter part the same
the Capt went on board of the Abraham Barker
Boats still up the Bay.

Barley in Shanty Bay
Thursday (Friday) 13th of Sept

First part of this 24 hours with not
raining weather saw no whales at 1 P.M. lowered away
2 Boats and went in shore after kergs
latter part a heavy squall from S.E. with thunder
and lightning at 4 P.M. the Boats came on board
from up the Bay at 6 P.M. the Boats came with
a good quantity of kergs.

Friday 14th

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze
saw a few whales Middle part the same sent
down the Foretopgalland yard at 4 A.M. took
our anchor and drifted down the Bay spoke the
Bark United states at 12 A.M. let go the anchor
in 13 fathoms of water off Elias Richards bluff
the Capt went on board Bark Eugene
latter part fine weather.

Saturday 15th

First part of this 24 hours a light breeze
at 4 A.M. lowered away the Boats.
Middle and latter part a strong breeze from
the W. the Boats still away.

Sunday 16th

First part of this 24 hours a light
breeze saw a few whales at 11 A.M. Capt Barker
went on board of the United states to see a
man that had got hurt by a whale at 3 P.M.
the Capt returned with the Capt of ship Charles
Phelps and Eugene at 4 P.M. the Boats came on
board latter part fine weather.
