

Thursday Wednesday Oct 16th 1856

This part of this 24 hours a strong breeze from the S.W. Middle & latter a fine breeze from the N.W. at 8 AM took and anchored and stood out of the harbor bound for port in company with the Robinhood.

Friday Thursday 17th

Begins with a fine breeze steering through the passage between Gillies and King's Shunter Middle part steering out for Western shore latter part the wind backed round to the S.W. light and hailing.

Saturday Friday 18th

This day begins with hailing wind but good weather steering down along the Western shore looking for Gen. Middle & latter part steering S.W. with a fine breeze in company with the Robinhood & Mystic.

Saturday

Sunday 19th

This day begins with a strong breeze from the S.E. steering S.W. wind S.W. the weather hazy Middle part a fine breeze from the N.W. steering S.W. latter part a strong breeze steering S.W. still in company with the Robinhood at 11 AM saw Conas Island bearing S.W. distant about 25 miles.

Sunday 20th

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze S.W. at 2 PM Conas Island bore N distant about 2 miles Middle part a strong breeze from the N.W. steering S.W. latter part a strong breeze steering S.W. with thick weather still in company with the Robinhood.
