

Ship Ben Duckin In Port
Saturday Dec 20th 1886

First part fine weather employed in Discharging all at 1000 lb finished work on board from the Reen 6 coils of tool line weighing 44 and 46 of Dried apples Latter part strong trades and rain hauled off from along side of the Reen and moved ship. Strong trades Discharged the Mate 1 Keelboard and 1 man

Sunday 21st Port Of Honolulu

First part strong trades and fine weather most of the crew on shore Middle part strong trades a little rain latter part much the same

Monday 22nd Port Of Honolulu

First part of this 24 hours strong trades and passing clouds employed in Dring and bunching Bone the caulker at work & caulking the ship outside

Middle part at work bunching the bone at 5 P.M. finished the bone strong trades and little showering the caulker still at work on the ship.

Tuesday 23rd Port Of Honolulu

First part of this 24 hours strong trades Most of the crew went on shore to see the Consul about the work the caulker still at work a carpenter at work putting a Keelboard Middle and Latter part the same strong trades.

Wednesday Dec 24th

First part strong trades the watch on Liberty Port the Bone on Board of the Eliza J. Stearn the ship watch breaking out the ground the bark Middle part some rain Latter the a few showers the watch on Liberty

Thursday 25th Port Of Honolulu

First part strong trades the starboard watch on Liberty the rest at work Dring oil out of the tank

Middle part the same Latter part fine weather & light breeze from S.E. the watch on Liberty

Friday 26th Port Of Honolulu

First part of this 24 hours strong from the S.E. and rain the Middle and latter part the same

Saturday the 27th Port Of Honolulu

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the S. and raining hard Middle part the same latter part rainy at times commenced to blow ground near

Sunday the 28th Port Of Honolulu

First part crew employed strong ground near Middle and latter part raining hard crew ashore

Monday the 29th

First part rainy most of the crew on Liberty Middle and latter part weather about the same at 11 A.M. hauled the ship a little in shore and left her Profile taken
