 lat 4.40 long 25.10

 lat 4.40 long 25.18

Friday November 5th 1915

 made all sail saw <sup>Schot</sup> Barab  
 wandered at 4.30 p.m.  
 so end the day  
 lat 4.05 long 25.47

Saturday 6  
 The day in fast part Calm in  
 latter part light winds from  
 South Barab wandered in  
 sail 2 more sails in sail  
 lat 3.45 long 26.30

Sunday 7  
 The day with strong breeze from  
 South and squally vessel under  
 Schot sail Barab wandered  
 in sail so end lat 2.30

 The day with strong breeze  
 East Sea vessel under  
 Schot sail heading SW by S.  
 Barab wandered in sail  
 lat 1.25 or. long 28.20

 all sail sprit 3 masts  
 Schoner put back on board  
 lat. 00 or. long 29.28

 saw the oil saw 3 masts Schoner  
 lat 1.50 South long 29.42
