Monday March 20th

1st day we got on way to sea
got 3 miles off shore strong
trade wind from sea and
we came back under land gale
so lay under calm so end 1st day

Tuesday 21

1st day with strong breeze from
north lay to anchorage at Salina
we could make so end 2nd day

Wednesday 22

1st day we left Salina for sea
with light breeze and calm at
5 pm we were off and made so
end 3rd day

Thursday 23

1st day we anchored at Enagua
with calm lay to anchorage over
night so end

Friday 24

1st day we left Enagua for sea
with fresh breeze so end
4th day

Saturday 25

1st day we put sail off land heading
west under all sail from 4 pm
even bedford so end 5th day

Sunday 26

1st day with light winds from SW vessel
under all sail heading by the winds
lat 25.46 long 73.14

Monday 27

1st day with calm vessel under all sail
so end lat 26.48 long 73.18

Tuesday 28

1st day with winds from SW
vessel heading west under all sail
so end lat 27.12 long 72.10

Wednesday 29

1st day with strong breeze and squalls
from west vessel heading west
lat 28.45 long 71.37

Thursday 30

1st day with strong breeze squalls
from east vessel under short sail
heading to west so end 6th day

Friday 31

1st day we lay to under storm
and squalls from East vessel under
short sail so end 7th day
lat 30.21 long 71.12

Saturday April 1st 1916

1st day winds fell from vessel
bath weather made all sail
heading by the winds even 1st day
bedford sail given Reefers duty
Reefers go to masthead so end
lat 30.48 long 71.27

Sunday 2

1st day with calm vessel under
short sail so end 8th day
lat 30.37 long 71.07

Monday 3

1st day with strong breeze from south
vessel heading west under all sail
lat 31.90 long 71.44
