Saturday 11
 The day with light winds and Calm
 Fench sailing and made all
 sail Cruising Roads
 lat 36.36. long 73.54
 later saw Schooner whals and
 Sailed got one

Sunday 12
 The day with light breeze and Calm
 Cutting the whals and Strad
 the works so end the day
 lat 36.44 long 73.54

 The day Fench sailing and
 Saw Chover Cloudy with boat
 down and and got one
 whals and I went on board
 lat 36.55 long 73.54

Sunday 14
 The day with Eaze Sea and
 light Breeze at daylight the Rais
 Sailed off whals and Drap the
 boat and catch 3 whals being
 long Sait Strad to Cutting
 then long Sait

Monday 15
 The day with Eaze Sea Strad to
 Cutting the whals Fench Cutting
 at 9 a.m. and Strad the
 works Cloudy in Sait
 so end the day
 lat 36.54 long 73.58

Tuesday 16
 The day with enflairing sailing
 the whals with Calm Schooner made
 in Sait and Schooner Cloudy
 in enflairing dirty so end

Wednesday 17
 The day Fench sailing
 the whals and later Strad
 to Reen and Sait Sails
 lat 36.50
