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May 31st. Raised sperm whales and lowered twice, but they were wild and could not get into strike. Very light breeze and smooth sea to squalls and rough weather in the evening and night. Lat 36-50. Long 72-00. Obs.

June 1st. Rain in the morning and light breeze with moderate swell. Most of the day fine and clear. Raised some grampas. Lat 37-05. Long 71-46

June 2nd. Carried on sail through the night, making toward the Westward. Wind died out at midnight. Very light swell. No wind all day. Clear sky. Lat 37-08. Long 71-50. Obs.

June 3rd. Light air and fog with moderate swell. Clear part of the day. Lat 37-40. Long 72-15.

June 4th. Light breeze and smooth sea. Clear weather. Raised a whale in company with the "P. Nelson" and fastened about 1 P.M. Commenced to cut in at 3 P.M. Lat 36-53. Long 72-20.

June 5th. Fine weather. Finished cutting in at 8 A.M. Started to boil in company with "P. Nelson". Lat 37-00. Long 71-37.

June 6th. Weather still very fine. Trying out. In company with "P. Nelson". Lat 37-14. Long 71-15.

June 7th. Finished trying out at 1 A.M. Lowered down the air today. Brist breeze from the South. Making for the Westward. "P. Nelson" on the weather bow. Moderate sea. Heavy squall at sunset. Lat 36-50. Long 72-34

June 8th. Fine weather. Clear sky. In company with "P. Nelson". Raised large school of whales at sundown. Lowered down the boats but didn't get anything. Kept under way through the night. Whales from 1000 to 2000 around until 10 P.M. Lat 36-30. Long 72-12.

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June 9th. Light breeze and moderate sea. Raised whales and lowered twice. Lat 36-50. Long 71-37.

June 10th. Calm and fine weather. Finished cutting in both whales at Simach. Began boiling at 8 P.M. Lat 37-08. Long 70-05.

June 11th. Calm sea and clear sky. Boiling. Broached a barrel of beef. Lighted a steamer at 3 P.M. Lat 37-14. Long 68-55.

June 12th. Day very hot. with calm sea and clear sky. Boiling. Lat 37-40. Long 67-30.

June 13th. Cloudy sky and mist. Light breeze. Boiling. Lat 38-33. Long 68-50.

June 14th. Weather very fine. Finished boiling at 9 P.M. Brist N.E. breeze through the night. Commenced W.B.S. Lat 38-15. Long 68-58.

June 15th. Mist and rain. All hands securing ship. Moderate sea and W.E. wind. L.W. course. Carried five markers (set). Lat. Long.

June 16th. Strong breeze and rough sea. Misty weather. Course S.W. Carried several sails and a steamer. Mist N.E. Lat 38-44. Long 72-30

June 17th. Rain and easterly gale with heavy sea. Lay to under tridents, drifting to Westward. No sight. Lat. Long. D.R.

June 18th. Heavy rain and easterly gale. Heavy sea. Lying to under tridents. Light in the afternoon for Long. Lat 37-30 D.R. Long 72-30.

June 19th. Weather cleared off through the night, and sea moderated. Carried steamer. Lat 37-10. Long 72-20.
