

At noon the gale became very strong, and the
high sea. Sun to be seen in evening but not
at 6 P.M. saw the Starboard beam of the
adrift. By midnight the rain cleared up
a little and wind commenced to go down.
Barometer 28.3 at noon. No night -
Lat 36-40 Long - 73-24 D.R.

July 11th At 4 A.M. wind and sea moderated.
Turned reefs out of trisails and set the
fore staysails. At 8 A.M. set foresail
and got. Rebuilt the flying jib.
Sighted a large bark and a number of
schooners. Sky cleared a little.
Lat 36-20. Long 74-18.

July 12th Very heavy swell and light breeze -
Sun out part of the day. Getting four
ready for boat, to replace the one stove-
boarded and went alongside of diminished
and waterlogged schooner, "The Line" of Boston.
A steamer came along and took her in tow.
They did not report any loss among the crew.
Lat 36-10 Long 74-10.

July 13th Sea moderating. Light breeze. Sighted the
Bk "Josephine" and Schr. "Carrie D Knowles".
Had a game after sunset.
Lat 37-00. Long 73-40

July 14th Fine weather and smooth sea. Sighted
the "Josephine" and "C D Knowles" all day.
Lat 37-18 Long 73-00.

July 15th Fresh S.W. breeze with smooth sea.
Josephine and Carrie D Knowles in sight.
School of grampas.
Lat 36-50 Long 72-52.

July 16th Light S.W. wind with choppy sea.
Sighted the "Josephine", "C D Knowles" and
Schr "C B Corwell". Had a game at sunset.
Lat 36-40 Long 72-45.

July 17th Bristle S.W. wind and squalls.
Carrie D Knowles and C B Corwell in
sight. Sea rough.
Lat 36-30 Long 72-30.

July 18th Strong S.W. wind and cross sea,

moderating in the afternoon. At sunset
set reefed mainsail with foresail and
jib and made for land. Came West.
Lat 37-00 Long 74-10

July 19th Made out Cape Charles at 4 P.M.
Rain squalls in the morning. Light
off shore breeze. Boat to windward
all day and anchored off Bush Bluff.
Light ship at dark.

July 20th Got under way at 4 A.M. and beat
up to Old Point Comfort on the flood
tide, every light S.W. wind. Anchored
off the fort at 11 A.M. Got under
way again at 2 P.M. and made for sea,
wind having veered around to the
Eastward. Came to anchor off Bush Bluff at
midnight.

July 21st Got under way at 4 P.M. Very
light off shore air. At about 10 P.M.
a gentle southerly breeze sprang up and
we shaped the course E by S.
Lat 36-50. Long 75-17.

July 22nd Fine weather and smooth sea.
Spoke the Str. "Niagara" of New York and
got some papers.
Lat 36-15. Long 74-55.

July 23rd Clear sky and fine weather. Sighted
the "Carrie D Knowles" in the afternoon.
Lat 35-25. Long 73-10.

July 24th Moderate breeze from the N.E.
Raised whales at about 1 P.M. and
got seven small ones. C D Knowles was
in company with us and got one.
Drove the sport boat slightly -
Lat 37-00 Long 72-15.

July 25th Smooth sea. Raised whales at day break.
and fastened to two. Carrie D Knowles
in sight. Began cutting them in at 4 P.M.
Lat 36-28 Long 70-18.

July 26th Smooth and fine weather. Trying
out. Carrie D Knowles in sight -
Lat 36-50 Long 69-15.
