Aug 1st Moderate swell and light S.W.
 wind with squalls. Lighted
 two steamers.

Aug 2nd Rained whales at day break. Each
 boat got one and got along side by
 10 A.M. Rough sea and fresh
 S.W. breeze. Got through cutting
 in at 4 P.M. and began to try out.
 Lat 37-03 Long 71-50

Aug 3rd Weather very fine with smooth sea
 Raising out. Light N.E. breeze.
 Lat 37-25 Long 71-10

Aug 4th Fresh S.W. wind and heavy sea.
 Finished trying out at 2 P.M. and set
 the fore sheet at 4 A.M. Started
 down the wh. Lighted several
 ships and a steamer.

 the night, clearing up a little at day break,

Aug 7th Squalls through the night. S.W. wind
 increased to a moderate gale with con-
 siderable squalls. Heavy sea.

 At 4 P.M. rained whales and struck a
 small cow. Got alongside at 7 P.M.

 of starboard boat disrupted for missing a
 large whale. Put as mate's loft.
 Mate's loft put as boatsteerer.

Aug 9th Calm and very little swell. Began
 to cut in at 5 A.M. and got through at
 7. Started to try out after breakfast.
 Lighted several steamers and sails.
 Lat 37-10 Long 72-10

Aug 10th Fine weather and light southerly breeze
 Rained whales in the morning. Lowered
 at 11 A.M. and struck a bull. Began to
 cut in at 3 P.M. and got through at 6.
 Lat 37-10 Long 71-52

Aug 11th Moderate S.W. wind and choppy sea.
 Raising out. Spoke Str. Crook of London.
 At 3 P.M.
 Lat 37-15 Long 72-00

Aug 12th Heavy S.W. squalls and rough sea.
 Stowed down all of the oil. Weather
 moderated some in the afternoon.
 Lat 36-00 Long 72-40
