Tue. May 6<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in with fine weather and very moderate. Steering to the North in company with the Knowles. Latter part the same. So ends this day.

Wed. 7<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in fine and very moderate. In company with the Carrie D. Knowles. Put up the foretop-mast and set up the rigging. Latter part very moderate. So ends this day.

Thurs. 8<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in with fine weather. In company with the Carrie D. Knowles. At 4 p.m. was abreast of the mole. Hairs very fresh breeze. So ends this day.

Fri. 9<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in with fine weather and a light breeze. At 7 a.m. came to anchor at Inagua in company with the Knowles. The crew employed in various jobs about ship. At 4 p.m. got underway with very little wind with the Knowles. So ends this day.

Sat. 10<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in very moderate and at noon was abreast of Castle Island in company with the Knowles. Latter part the same. So ends this day.

Sun. 11<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in with fine weather. At one p.m. made Watlings Island and at 7 p.m. was abreast of it. Put out the starboard chain and took the starboard anchor off the bow. Saw a few steamers. So ends this day.

Mon. 12<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in with a fresh breeze. Vessel steering to the North in company with the Carrie D. Knowles. Latter part the same. Lat. 25-17 Long. 75-15. So ends this day.

Tue. 13<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in with fine weather. Vessel steering to the North with all sail out in company with the Knowles. Latter part the same. Lat. 27-14 Long. 75-17. So ends this day.

Wed. 14<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in with fine weather and very moderate. Vessel heading to the North in company with the Knowles. Latter part the same. Lat. 28-44 Long. 75-12. So ends this day.

Thurs. 15<sup>th</sup>.

This day comes in with fine weather. Course North in company with the Knowles. Lat. 29-44 Long. 75-29. So ends this day.

Fri. May 16

This day comes in with a fresh breeze. At 7 a.m. shortened sail in company with the Knowles. Vessel steering to the North. Latter part equally and rainy. So ends this day. Lat. 30-14

Sat. 17.

This day comes in with good weather. Vessel steering to the North with the Knowles. Saw 3 steamers. Latter part the same. Lat. 31-23 Long. 74-59. So ends this day.

Sun. 18

This day comes in with a fine breeze from S.W. At 10.30 a.m. Carrie D. Knowles raised 2 whales. Landed for them but lost sight of them as the boats came aboard. and at 5 p.m. went down to covered and packed the Carrie. So ends this day. Long. 74-58

Mon. 19.

This day comes in with a fresh breeze. Vessel steering to the North crossing the Gulf Stream in company with the Knowles. Saw blackfish. At sunset put the vessel under 2 topsails. So ends this day. Long. 74-45.

Tue. 20

This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. At 5.30 a.m. raised a school of whales. Landed for them and got fast to two brought them alongside and took in. Raised more whales. Covered and got fast to one. At 6 p.m. finished cutting in the three. Raised more whales. Covered and got one. Breezing up fresh from the N.E. made the whale fast for the night. All hands went to work on the heads. So ends this day. Lat. 36-16 Lat. one whale. Heavy breeze.

Wed. 21.

This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E. vessel heading to the North with two topsails and four staysail. At 4 p.m. set the works again. moderating and fair weather. So ends this day. Lat. 36-59 Long. 72-20

Thurs. 22

This day comes in with fine weather. all hands employed in working on oil and boiling. Latter part the same. So ends this day. Lat. 36-55 Long. 73-40
