Sat. 28. This day comes in with a light breeze from the Southward. Steaming S.E. by E with all sail out in company with a three masted. Crew employed in laying sheathing on deck. Latter part moderate. Lat 34.57 Long 68.08 So ends this day.

Sun. 29. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.W. At 11 a.m. took in the main-sail and set the topsail at 2 p.m. wind hauled W.W.S. and at 6 p.m. took in fly-jib and put a single reef in the fore-sail. Course South-  
Lat 36.49 Long 66.49 So ends this day.

Mon. 30. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from S.E. and rain. Put another reef in the fore-sail and sent the fly-jib in. Latter part the same. Lat 32.22 Long 66.22 So ends this day.

Tue. 31. This day comes in with a light breeze from the Southward. At 6 a.m. set the main-sail. At 4 p.m. breeze up fresh and at 6 p.m. put a single reef in the main-sail. Course S.E. by E. Lat 32.21 Long 66.58 So ends this day.

Wed. Apr. 1. This day comes in with a fine breeze from the Westward. Lat 5 a.m. took the reef out of the main-sail and set the top-sail. At 8 a.m. set the stay-sail. Crew employed in various about ship. At 7 p.m. took in the sail and main-sail. moderate, heavy swell and rainy. Course S.E. by E. So ends this day. Lat 30.52 Long 64.56

Thur. 2. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the W.E. At 7 p.m. took in stay-sail and top-sail. Latter part the same. So ends this day. Lat 29.50 Long 63.25

Fri. 3. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the W.E. Latter part the same. So ends this day. Lat 27.02 Long 62.20

Sat. 4. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the Eastward. Vessel under short sail all day. Latter part the same with rain. So ends this day. Lat 24.42 Long 61.25

Sun. 5. This day comes in with a light breeze from N.E. All sail out steering to the Southward. Latter part the same. So ends this day. Lat 23.13 Long 60.56

Wed. 8. This day comes in with a moderate and rainy. Latter part the same. So ends this day. No observation.

Thur. 9. This day comes in with the trade winds light from the Eastward. Crew employed in painting ship. Latter part the same. So ends this day. Lat 19.13 Long 60.35

Fri. 10. This day comes in with the trades from the Eastward. Crew employed in various jobs about ship. At 3 p.m. made land. Described one point - no weather now. So ends this day. At noon Lat 17.07 Long 61.04

Sat. 11. This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.E. and at 7 a.m. Capt. went on shore at Grand Bourg, Marie Galante and at 9.30 a.m. came to anchor at Poudre. Crew went on shore and brought off some wood. So ends this day.

Sun. 12. This day comes in moderate. Broke out the shore and stowed away the wood and at 8 a.m. crew went on shore and got some more wood and came along-side with it. At 1 p.m. got underway for St. Vincent at 4 p.m. got a calm off the northern point of Dominica. So ends this day.

Mon. 13. This day comes in with a light breeze. Vessel steering to the Southward for St. Vincent. Latter part rainy and very moderate. So ends this day.

Tue. 14. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the Eastward. At day-light off the Southern point of Martinique at noon off St. Vincent with it moderate and at 5 p.m. off St. Vincent very moderate. So ends this day.

Wed. 15. This day comes in with a light breeze. At 11 a.m. came to anchor in Kingstown harbor St. Vincent. Saw James Pidge, Esq. Grant and Percy Gibby a couple of days leave. Latter part the same. So ends this day.

Thur. 16. This day comes in with fine weather. Lying at anchor in Kingstown harbor. Crew employed in working on fly-jib. So ends this day.
