Fri. 17

This day comes in with fine weather. At 10 a.m. went on shore and signed 9 men and at 1 p.m. got underway for Haiti. So ends this day.

Sat. 18 This day comes in very moderate. Vessel steering to the Westward. Saw hundreds of Latter part the same. So ends this day. Lat 13.30 Long 64.01

Sun. 19 This day comes in with fine weather also. moderate. Saw one schooner steering to the North. Latter part the same. Lat 14.31 Long 65.44

Mon. 20

This day comes in with fine weather and light wind. Crew employed in various jobs. Lat 15.25 Long 67.25

Tues. 21 This day begins with fine weather. Vessel steering to the N.E. One steamer in sight. Latter part the same. Lat 15.50 Long 69.12 All at sea in sight.

Wed. 22

This day comes in with fresh breeze. At 10 a.m. came to anchor in Grand Cazeau in company with the C.D. Knoller of Providence. Crew employed in working on rigging. So ends this day.

Thurs. 23 This day comes in moderate. Vessel lying at anchor in company with the C.D. Knoller. Crew working on the rigging. So ends this day.

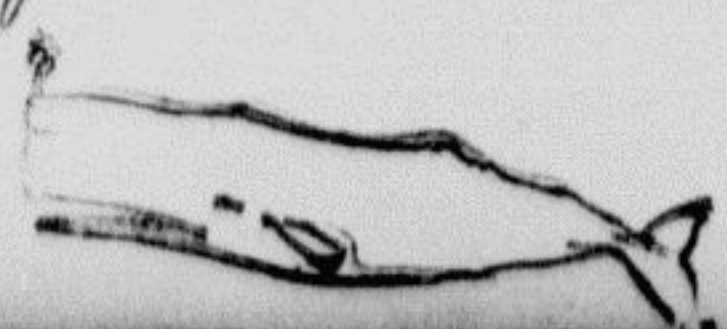
Fri. 24 This day comes in fine. At anchor with Knoller. Crew employed in various jobs. So ends this day.

Sat. 25 This day comes in very moderate. At 4 a.m. got underway for Tiburon. At 6 a.m. died out calm with a ground swell. At 5 p.m. breezed up fresh with trade winds steering to the Westward with Knoller. So ends this day.

Sun. 26

This day comes in with fresh trades. At 10 a.m. abreast of La. Vache and at noon raised breeches but could not make them out. At 3 p.m. came to anchor in a small bay. with Knoller. So ends this day.

Mon. 27 This day comes in with fine weather at 4 a.m. got underway for Tiburon. At 6 a.m. raised a school of whales. Lowered away and got 2 and the Knoller got one. Came alongside with them came to anchor at Port Abenece. Cut the whale in and cut the head up. So ends this day.

Tues. 28

This day comes in with fine weather. At 6 a.m. hooked on to the whale and at 9.30 finished cutting. Set the works aground and cut up the head very moderate. So ends this day.

Wed. 29

This day comes in with moderate weather. At 4 a.m. got underway in company with the Knoller. At 8 p.m. bore too. So ends this day.

Thurs. 30

This day comes in with fine weather. Crew employed in working on whales. Latter part the same. So ends this day.

Fri. May 1

This day comes in with fine weather. At 10 a.m. came to anchor in Tiburon. Crew employed in taking water and other jobs about ship. So ends this day.

Sat. May 2

This day comes in with rain squalls. Crew employed in various jobs, taking water, trading and washing the vessel. At 4 p.m. finished up everything and at 6 p.m. got underway for Inagua. So ends this day.

Sun. 3

This day comes in very moderate and a heavy swell. At 11 a.m. took in the main sail. Latter part the same. So ends this day.

Mon. 4

This day comes in moderate. Made sail and at 3 p.m. was off Grande Island in company with the C.D. Knoller. So ends this day.

Tues. 5

This day comes in moderate. At noon breezed up fresh and at 4 p.m. was off Pearl Point. Left for St. for Inagua at 6 p.m. put a reef in the main sail. So ends this day.

Wed. 6

This day comes in moderate. At 5 a.m. took out the reef and at 9 a.m. anchored at Inagua. Went on shore and got letters. Crew employed in painting and tarring the spring-logs. At 5 p.m. got underway with a light breeze. So ends this day.

Thurs. 7

This day comes in fresh. At 7 a.m. was abreast of Castle Island and at 1 p.m. was abreast of Bird Rock. Latter part fresh breeze. So ends this day.
