This day Commences with Squall from the S. at 10 A.M. Cleared of some of the mounds and run to the S. on three mounds in sight at 2 P.M. Commences to rain look in the mounds at 3 P.M. raised Whales coming to the mounds lower for them 2 Boat struck the other Boat set main sail and beat up to the boat look the whole along side look in the mounds and run to the North so end the day

June 6th

This day Commences with light breeze and squally at day light got up the ceiling gear on Commence to cut in the whole at nine finished cutting at 12 P.M. set the work a going so end the day sick men of duty

June 7

This day Commences with breeze from the S. and squally, saw four streams on the mounds at 4 P.M. finished boiling at the for try sail so end the day sick men of duty

June 8

This day Commences with fresh breeze and squally from the S. at day light Commence to slow down the air at 10 A.M. Cleared of look up the ceiling gear to day at 4 P.M. finished stormy rain and work up sick so end the day sick men of duty

June 9

This day Commences with light winds from S. crew employed in working up breast at 10 A.M. came back at 1 P.M. Cleared of all the foresail and mounds and took to S.E. at 2 P.M. down look in sail saw 3 mounds so end the day sick men of duty

June 10

This day Commences light winds from the S. at 10 A.M. all sail and slow to the S.E. at 3 P.M. came in to the stream from up fresh look in the main sail so end the mounds so end the day sick men of duty

June 11

This day Commences light breeze and rain at 10 A.M. a gale from the S.E. at 4 P.M. bore to under the try sails spoke one stream so end the day sick men of duty

June 12

This day Commences with fresh gale from N.W. run of to the S. the old London Calm spoke the Cape Knobs had two hundred feet of air so end the day sick men of duty

June 13

This Commences with light breeze from the N.W. at 5 A.M. made all sail and stood to the N. the boat calm at 10 A.M. look in sail so end the day sick men of duty

June 14

This day Commences with Calm at 10 A.M. a light squall from S.W. at 1 P.M. raised Whales on Combing with the Cape Knobs lower and got on and cut him 'Carni' got to so end the day

June 15

This day Commences with fresh breeze from the West but the black down the hole look on of the whole from Cape and cut him under the Ref man sail at 5 P.M. had the second cut - blowing a gale from the N.W. look in the mounds at 10 P.M. inf for sail and by day so end the day

June 16

This day Commences with fresh gale from the N.W. at 5 A.M. shook the reef out of the fore staysail at 4 P.M. shook one reef out of the foresail so end the day

June 17

This Commences with light breeze from the N.W. at 7 A.M. raised Whales lower and got on work down along side look in the mounds heavy sand but try sail are seen to that to get one of the lines so end the day

June 18

This day Commences with fresh breeze from the S. at day light - Call all hand and Commence to cut in the whole at 11 A.M. finished cutting look in the mounds Commence on the hook so end the day sick men of duty

June 19

This day Commences with light breeze from N.W. at 9 A.M. raised Whales lower for them 2 B struck off the whole got the line around him and hauled the iron out - lost the whole at 6 P.M. finished boiling so end the day sick men of duty
