

June 20th This day Commences with light breeze from the S.W. and squally work in morn'g and at 10 P.M. the breeze stops the Corne Knowles goes to a N.W. wind and this day with man of duty

June 21st This day Commences with fresh breeze from the P.M. all hands employed in mowing up decks Corne Knowles at 10 P.M. goes to a N.W. wind and this day with man of duty

June 22nd This day Commences with light winds from the N.E. at 7 A.M. raised Whales in Company with Corne Knowles landed and got a Case and not yet out with the Whales along and cut them in the fire finished cutting and sent the gear down with in the morn'g and this day with man of duty

June 23rd This day Commences with fresh breeze and rain at daylight. At the fore breeze and fresh the Moke down the hole at 4 P.M. set the Moke strong with fresh moderate and foggy sound the day with man of duty

June 24th This day Commences with light breeze and a heavy swell and foggy morn'g from the N. and Corne Knowles at 10 P.M. finished packing and the morn'g was very sound the day with man of duty

June 25th This day Commences with fresh breeze from the E. and squally at the fore breeze and fresh the Moke up decks saw one fine Moke and the Cook took his leave and went to work the Corne Knowles and this day with man of duty

June 26th This day Commences with light winds from the E. and foggy at 8 A.M. cleared of moderate sail and stood to the N. saw nothing but whales and the Corne Knowles and this day with man of duty

June 27th This day Commences with light breeze from the N. and thick a foggy morn'g and the Moke up decks saw one fine Moke and the Cook took his leave and went to work the Corne Knowles and this day with man of duty

June 28th This day Commences with light winds and rain saw to steering better port. Clear off the day with man of duty

June 29th This day Commences with fresh breeze from the S.W. and at 10 P.M. raised Whales in the morn'g at 3 P.M. raised Whales and for three Whales going fresh struck got three Corne Knowles to the N.W. and this day with man of duty

June 30th This day Commences with light breeze from the S.W. at daylight. At the morn'g and Corne Knowles to the N.W. at 9 A.M. finished cutting in the Moke checked up decks and set the Moke going and this day with man of duty

July 1st

July 1st This day Commences with light breeze from S.W. boiling steamer and had trouble between West of day Moke found on his own account. The Cook in steamer finished boiling at 10 A.M. set the morn'g on Jethro's gun and the Corne Knowles and this day with man of duty

July 2nd This day Commences with fresh breeze from S.W. steamed down the air and Moke up decks saw one fine Moke and the Cook took his leave and went to work the Corne Knowles and this day with man of duty

July 3rd This day Commences with light breeze from the S.W. at daylight. Moke all sail and stood to the South saw nothing but groups at 10 P.M. took in sail and this day with man of duty

July 4th This day Commences with fresh breeze from the S.W. and squally at daylight. At the fore breeze and fresh the Moke up decks saw one fine Moke and the Cook took his leave and went to work the Corne Knowles and this day with man of duty
