This day Commences with light breeze from the N. at 7 A.M. raised the whole for the got. To Corri Knowles in light - put the gear and cut - then in at 2 P.M. fresh breeze at 4 - raised the whole a few calm got too more whole at 10 P.M. put the gear and got the whole for the night - so end the day

July 9th

This day Commences with light breeze from the N.E. Collier had a long light - and put up the gear and got the whole for the night - raised the whole for the night - so end the day

July 10th

July 16th

This day Commences with light breeze from the N.W. at 7 A.M. set the main sail and got the gear at 2 A.M. raised freshes kept for the full sail not see them until 11 A.M. made them and to the whole toward for them and got on in company with the Corri Knowles too the whole along side of her - so end the day

July 17th

This day Commences with light breeze from the N.W. all daylight - set the main sail and gaff topsail at 8 A.M. raised a school of whales in company with the Corri Knowles toward for them L.B. with on and struck took the whole along side of the Corri Knowles at 4 P.M. finished today - so end the day

July 18th

This day Commences with light breeze from the N.W. but thick fog toward of the Corri Knowles at 3 P.M. a large came from the S. kept of to the N.W. running to the main sail and set the by sail - so end the day
