 July 19th This day Commences with a gale from the S.W. and heavy squalls put the Boat on after Carina by way the try Saw also four by sea at sundown Miners hauled to the Westward and Moraine saw a man & was staying to the N.E. so end this day

July 20th This day Commences with light winds from the S.W. & S. M. but the Moraine and Joffe sail saw nothing more employed in various jobs about deck so end this day

July 21st This day Commences with light breeze an squally but the Moraine sail at 10 A.M. saw a rain squall. Called this Whales got the food today but turned out to be grasshopper Carri Knives in sight and one then Moraine saw Collier from the deck of so end this day

July 22nd This day Commences with light winds from the South Carri Knives in sight at 4 pressed up fresh put on reef in the main sail at 7 P.M. took in the main sail and flogging and forecast saw a finch from the N.W. Rainier all night so end this day

July 23rd This day Commences with light winds and squally at 8 A.M. Pleasa of much all sail over to the South latter Part Calm took all sail and set the try sails saw nothing but fishes so end this day

July 24th This day Commences with fresh breeze from the N.E. at 8 A.M. took reef the foresail sent down the fore topmast Collier per Moraine at 1 P.M. sent the mainmast and flogging sail so end this day

July 25th This day Commences with light breeze from the N. at day light - made all sail and stood the South at 8 A.M. raised a school of Whales toward for them L.B. struck the Green Cam and Cam stood and stood to the Southward at 5 A.M. raised a school of Cow Whales took fast struck gold the Whales got them along side and more fast at 9 P.M. so end this day

July 26th This day Commences with fresh breeze from the Westward at day light. Called all hands and set the mainmast and got up the fore end Commenced 10 Cut in the Whales at 9 A.M. further cutting at 12 A.M. saw Whales toward and got on with them along side at 6 P.M. set the work going

July 27th This day Commences with fresh breeze from the N.E. at 10 A.M. flogging Phail port and took the Whales from along side it rough to see any thing at 10 A.M. set the main sail and flogging and set the S.M. saw one thru mastah deck so end this day

July 28th This day Commences with Calm at 7 A.M. finished toiling stowed part of the Oil poke out the hole and Coasting and Joffe Cook latter part light breeze from the S.W. saw grasshopper and fishes at sundown took all sail but trypair and fore stop sail so end this day

July 29th This day Commences with fresh breeze from the S.W. at 7 A.M. saw a school of Whales toward for them took today got fast to the Whales a long side and Commenced to Cut in at 3 P.M. further cutting. Made to work on the heads Carri Knives in sight so end this day

July 30th This day Commences with fresh breeze from the S.W. at 6 A.M. set the works going spoke the the ship Golden City one hundred barrels of Oil spoke the steam Chacecon so end this day

July 31st This day Commences with light breeze from the S.W. during it for home saw one the Moraine wh. at 10 A.M. wind hauled to the N.W. set the mainmast and flogging sail so end this day

Aug 1st This day Commences with light breeze from the N.E. took a squally rain saw two ships lost in the Moraine at 1 P.M. at 10 A.M. finished today stowing down got on a school so end this day

Aug 2nd This day Commences with light breeze from the N.W. all hands employed stowing down Oil latter part Calm saw 60 staves stowing to the Westward so end this day

Aug 3rd This day Commences with a light air from the N.E. at 10 A.M. set up the fore topmast and Carri Knives the head outboard Collier port Calm so end this day
