 Sat. Apr. 23rd This day comes in with fresh trade winds from the North. At 8 a.m. set mainsail & jib & sail and steered her S. by E. At 11 a.m. main boom left parted took in mainsail and put on new left and set it again. Latter part a good breeze. So ends this day.

Sun. 24th This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the North vessel under all sail steering to the Southward. Latter part the same. One Barque in sight. So ends this day. Lat 25-44 Long 58-33

Mon. 25th This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the North and heavy rain squalls steering to the Southward under lower sails. At 8 a.m. took up the chains. At 7 p.m. cleared off. So ends this day.

Tues. 26th This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. vessel under all sail steering to the Southward. Gray Gibon steward could not do his duty and went forward on his own account. Put Timothy Kydd in to act as steward. Latter part the same. So ends this day.

Wed. 27th This day comes in with trade winds from the North vessel under all sail steering South. men employed in various jobs about ship. So ends this day.

Thurs. 28th This day comes in with trade winds from the Eastward vessel under all sail steering to the South. At 5 p.m. took off the boat from the stern and put on the waist. Latter part raining. So ends this day.

Friday 29th This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the Eastward. At 4 a.m. sighted Trinidad and at noon boat went on shore at Grand Bourg Marie Jacarite. At 2 p.m. vessel came to anchor at La. Claire at 5 p.m. left there for St. Vincent. So ends this day.

Sat. 30th This day begins with a calm vessel lying off Dominica at noon breezed up fresh and at 7 p.m. abreast of Martinique with a good breeze. So ends this day.

Sun. May 1st This day comes in with a fresh breeze at 5 a.m. vessel abreast of the sugar loaf and at 7 p.m. vessel came to anchor at Kingstown St. Vincent. Gave Gray Gibon and Edward Spence two days leave. So ends this day.

Mon. 2nd This day comes in with good weather vessel lying at anchor in Kingstown harbor. Gave Herbert Kydd, Geo. Grant Nathaniel Lewis, Timothy Kydd James Blagel and Alfred Kydd two days leave. men employed in various jobs about ship. So ends this day.

 Tues. 3rd This day comes in fine vessel lying at anchor in Kingstown harbor crew employed in various jobs about ship also painting outside. So ends this day.

Wed. 4th This day comes in fine. At 11 a.m. sighted 10 men. At 2 p.m. left for Dominica and at 9 p.m. was abreast of the sugar leaves St. Lucia. So ends this day.

Thurs. 5th This day comes in with fine weather. At 7 a.m. saw black-fish lowered for them but did not see them again. At 8 p.m. came to anchor in Kingstown Dominica. So ends this day.

Fri. 6th This day begins with fine weather vessel lying at anchor in company with Scho. Frederick Rosecr. Bark. Greyhound and A.R. Tucker and Drighlerson were employed in taking wood and water and trading. So ends this day.

Sat. 7th This day comes in with rain at 10 a.m. left for St. Eustatius. Latter part the same. So ends this day.

Sun. 8th This day comes in with fine at 4 a.m. abreast of Wouterat and at 2.30 p.m. came to anchor at Kingstown St. Eustatius in company with the Bark Bertha and Scho. E. A. Griff and Adelia Chase. So ends this day.

Mon. 9th This day comes in fine vessel lying at anchor crew employed in setting up rigging and getting provisions. At 5 p.m. got underway in company with the Bertha and Chase for sea. So ends this day.

Tues. 10th This day comes in with rain. Vessel steering to the N. At 7 a.m. lost sight of Sombroso. Adelia Chase in sight without the chains and put them below. Latter part fine. So ends this day.

Wed. 11th This day comes in fine steering to the N. At. in company with the Adelia Chase. Latter part the same. So ends this day.

Thurs. 12th This day comes in fine and moderate in company with the Chase. Latter part the same. So ends this day. Lat 21-59 Long 65-57
