Mon. 16th This day comes in with it moderate
and a few rain squalls vessel steering to the
N.W. At 5 p.m. jibed over and steering N. by E.
in company with a three masted So ends this day.

Tue. 17th This day comes in with fine weather
vessel under mainmast steering to the N.
Latter part the same So ends this day
Lat 27-44 Long 70-22

Wed. 18th This day comes in with a fresh breeze from
the Southward vessel under short sail steering

Lat 28-12 Long 70-22

Thur. 19th This day begins with a fresh breeze from the
Southward vessel under short sail steering to
the N.W. Latter part the same So ends this day

steering to the N.W. At 7 p.m. reefed the main-

and a good breeze from the N.W. vessel under
lower sails steering to the N.W. At noon took in the
main-sail and reefed the fore-sail At 4 p.m. set the

the S. S. Sumner and Golden City of New Bedford At 7 p.m.
took in sail So ends this day
Lat 36-47 Long 73-26

Thur. 26th This day comes in moderate At 5 a.m.
made sail and stood to the Southward in company
with the Sumner and Golden City of New Bedford did not
calm and at 6 p.m. breezed up fresh raised a
school of whales gave chase whales going quick gave
them up and took in sail heading to the Westward

Fri. 27th This day comes in with a fresh breeze from
the S.W. At 5 a.m. made sail and stood to the
Southward Saw Sumner and Golden City. Take 2 whales
quick stood to the Westward all day Latter part the same
Lat 36-50 Long 73-44

Sat. 28th Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E.
vessel under 2 jibs, fore-sail, and top-sail all day
steering to the Eastward At 4 p.m. gained the Adelia
of N. Bedford At sunset took in fore-sail.
Lat 36-42 Long 73-20

Sun. 29th Comes in with a light breeze from S.W. At 5 a.m.
raised whales in company with the Thane lowered for them
got one whale aboard came alongside and hooked on
to him finished cutting left of the Thane came aboard
cut up the head and started the works again.

Mon. 30th This day comes in with a fresh breeze from
the S.W. vessel under jibs and main-sail boiling
At 9 a.m. raised a breach could not make it out
Took in main-sail at sunset.
Lat 37-14 Long 73-36

Tue. 31st Comes in with good weather in company
with the Thane boiling Golden City in sight
Latter part the same Lat 37-01 Long 73-46

Wed. June 1st Comes in very moderate from the S.W. At
10 a.m. Capt. of the Thane came on board gave him
5 lbs of oil. Did not calm took in the main-sail
and at 1 p.m. raised a school of whales lowered for
them and the Thane got one mating with us. At 6 p.m.
lowered for more whales but to late boats came aboard.
Lat 36-40 Long 73-50 + 10
