5 Whales

Tue 21 Comes in with a fresh breeze and rough from the S.W. At 4 a.m. put a reef in the main-sail and hove on to the whale. Faded Chase came down and took one whale to cut in at 7 a.m. finished cutting our whale took in the main-sail and kept off North a very heavy breeze and heavy sea from the S.W. men cutting up heads and boiling oil at 4 p.m. let the vessel come in heading to the Westward

Wed. 22 Comes in with a fresh breeze and rough from the S.W. Crew employed in working on oil A. Chase in sight also one Barge
 Lat. 38-37 Long. 71-50

Thurs. 23 Comes in with fine weather vessel under all sail steering to the S.W. At 6 p.m. spoke the A. Chase. Took in sail
 Lat. Long 72-19

Fri. 24 Comes in with good weather raised whales lowered for them in company with the Chase. we got three and the Chase got two brought them along side and cut in two raised more whales lowered but did not get any made the other whale fast for the night
 Lat. 37-40 Long. 71-58

Whales lost 3

Sat. 25 Comes in moderate At 4:30 hooked on to the whale and at 7 a.m. finished cutting and raised a school of whales lowered and got one came along side and hooked on to him finished cutting at noon at 2 p.m. raised another school of whales lowered and got two brought them along side and made fast for the night a fresh breeze from the S.W. Lost two whales.

Sun. 26 Comes in with a fresh breeze from S.W. and rough At 4:30 a.m. put a reef in the main-sail and commenced to cut the whales At noon finished cutting. Spoke an English Steamer. Crew all employed in various jobs on oil Latter part the same Lat. works aground at noon.

 Mon. June 27 Comes in with fine weather Crew all employed in working on oil vessel running to the Westward with main-sail on got one porpoise Also washing decks.

Tue. 28 Comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. Raised a school of whales lowered for them and struck two came along side with them and hooked on finished cutting one and cut up one head made the other whale fast for the night
 Lat. 38-28 Long. 71-20

Whales 2

Wed. 29 Comes in with fine weather and southerly wind. At 4 a.m. hooked on to the whale and began to cut. Finished cutting and went to work on the head and set the works aground Latter part the same.
 Lat. 38-46 Long. 70-20

Thurs. 30 Comes in with a fresh breeze from the Southward. Crew all employed in working on oil Latter part the same
 Lat. 38-49

Fri. July 1 Comes in with a fresh breeze from the Southward also squally and raining Crew employed in working on oil Latter part weather better
 Long. 72-09

Sat. 2nd Comes in with good weather made all sail and started to the Southward Saw blackfish Crew employed in cleaning ship. Killed a pig.
 Lat. 37-01 Long. 72-10

Sun. 3rd Comes in with fine weather and wind backing. At 11 a.m. raised whales lowered for them and the barbed boat got two and the waist-boat got one At dark picked up the last boat and made the whales fast for the night. Chase in sight with whales.
 Lat. Long. 70-51

Whales 3

Mon. 4th Comes in with a light breeze from the Eastward At 4:30 a.m. hooked on to the whale and began to cut and at 5 p.m. finished cutting the 3 whales and also had the heads cut up and cleared away set the works aground and began to boil.
 Lat. 37-50 Long. 71-56

Tue. 5th Comes in with a fresh breeze from S.W. and choppy Crew all employed in working on oil A. Chase in sight.
 Lat. 38-12 Long. 71-47
