oil and cleaning the ship. At 4 p.m. finished up everything
Took in sail

Fri. 8

Comes in with a light breeze from the North. Made
sail and stood to the Southward in company with the A. Chase
Lat 37-57 Long 72-00

Sat. 9th

Wind comes in from the N.E. and fair
weather. Vessel steering to the Westward in company
with the A. Chase.

Sun. 10

Lat 37-25 Long 73-20
Light breeze from Southward. Lowered the boat
and tried to head off 2 Steamers bound South-
without success. Latter part calm.

Mon. 11

Lat 37-05 Long 73-30
Light breeze from S.W. At 5 a.m. A. Chase had
her boat down chasing whales and at 9 a.m. raised
the whales and lowered. Could not get near them
so gave up the chase and boat came aboard at 5 p.m.
went on board of the C.R. Swift.

Lat 37-00 Long 73-37
Light breeze and smooth from S.W. At 5 a.m.
raised whales lowered and got one came along side
and hooked on to him and finished cutting at noon
and set four sail to cruise. Set irons aground at
5 p.m.

Lat 37-04 Long 74-02
Comes in with a fresh North. Crew employed in
boiling oil and working about ship.

Thur. 14

Lat 37-17 Long 72-50
Comes in with a fresh breeze from the
North. Raised a school of whales at 8 a.m.
lowered and got two. Boats came along side and
commenced to cut. Finished cutting. Swift, Chase, and
A. City in sight.

Fri. 15

Lat 37-04 Long 73-30
Comes in calm at 7 a.m. saw Chase
with boat down. Lowered but did not get near
the whales. Raised more whales and gave chase
Vain boat just picked one whale, whales went to
windward gave them up and came aboard and
kept off for Cape Henry with a fresh breeze from
the S.W.

36-45 - 74-04

July 16

Journal Continued
Comes in with a light breeze from
the S.W. At 7 a.m. A boat went along-
side of a Tug boat and got a tow up to
Cape Henry and got letters from the Pilot boat.
At 1 p.m. boat got back to the vessel, kept off
to the Eastward. Thundering and raining.

July 17

Comes in moderate vessel steering to the
Eastward got one porpoise also one dolphin

Mon. 18

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the West-
ward vessel steering to the Eastward and Steamers
and one vessel in sight.

Tue. 19

Lat 36-47 Long 73-53
Comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W.
at 5 a.m. raised a school of whales going to
windward lowered for them and gave chase. At 8 a.m.
called boats aboard and gave them up. Steered to the
S.W. Latter part wind to the Westward.

Wed. 20

Lat 37-17 Long 73-50
Comes in with a fresh breeze from the
Westward. At 7 a.m. raised a school of
whales going to lowered. Lowered the boats
and the Starboard boat struck one. Came along-
side with him. Larboard boat just going on to a
whale when the rudder gave away so gave up and
came aboard and cut in the whale and set the
works aground.

Thur. 21

Lat 36-55 Long 73-22
Comes in moderate. At 10 a.m. raised 3
whales going to lowered close by the vessel gave chase
but whales went out of sight so gave them up
and stood to the Westward.

Fri. 22

Lat 37-32 Long 72-25
Comes in moderate and raining crew
employed in working on oil and cleaning the ship.
Latter part the same.

Sat. 23

Lat 73-40
Comes in moderate and rainy at 9 a.m. went
along side of a N.Y. Steamer and got some papers.
Latter part the same.
