Nov 8

This day begins with a light breeze from the N.E. At 8 a.m. made sail and kept her S.S. At 12 noon saw black-fish went out and struck seven and saved four brought them alongside and hauled them on deck and cut them up. Spoke the Brig James D. at 12. So ends this day. Lat 37-12 Long 73-37

Nov 9

This day begins with it calm and thick fog. Crew all employed in working on fish. At 4 p.m. cleared off some and raised a school of whales. Tricked for them but did not get near as whales were going to windward quick. So ends this day. Long 73-28

Nov 10

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.E. At 6 a.m. raised a school of whales. lowered for them but it breezed up fresh. So the boat came on board whalers went to lowered quick. At 11 a.m. spoke the E.A. Swift of Providence cutting at 11-15 raised more whales lowered and got two brought them alongside and made fast for the night. So ends this day.

Nov 11

This day comes in with a heavy breeze from the E.W.E. At 5 a.m. cut away the whales vessel under fore-stay-sail. Two reef fore-sail and try-sail. At 8 a.m. it began to moderate. We ship and found the whales sent a boat out and brought them both alongside and hooked on to them. and at 5 p.m. finished cutting. took in the main-sail and went to work cutting up heads. calm and a little swell. So ends this day.

Sat 13

This day begins with a fresh breeze from the S.W. At 8 a.m. raised a school of whales lowered and struck one came alongside and began to cut in. Finished cutting at 3 p.m. and started to bid raised more whales went down and got one came alongside and made fast for the night. Long 74-03 So ends this day.

Sun 14

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W. Crew all employed in working on oil. So ends this day. Lat 36-58 Long 74-00

Nov 15

This day begins with a fresh breeze from the N.W. and rainy. At 5 a.m. raised whales alongside and at 7 a.m. lowered and struck two. At 12 noon came alongside with whales and at 2 hooked on to them and finished cutting and clearing away the heads at 8 p.m. So ends this day. Lat 36-57

Nov 16

This day begins with a fresh breeze from the S.W. Crew employed in working on oil. Latter part the same. Lat 37-37 So ends this day.

Nov 17

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W. and foggy. Crew all employed in working on oil. Latter part the same. Long 74-14 So ends this day.

Nov 18

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W. Crew employed in storing down oil. At 2 p.m. raised blackfish down for them but gave up. Saw Bark Bertha. So ends this day. Lat 37-18 Long 74-10

Nov 19

This day begins with a light breeze from the N.E. At 5 a.m. raised whales lowered for them and struck three and brought them alongside and hooked on to them at 2 p.m. and at 6 p.m. finished cutting and cleared away the heads. So ends this day. These whales in sight. Lat 38-50
