May Sat 20

This day begins with a fresh N.E. wind but all employed in working on oil. Two whales in sight. Latter part more moderate. So ends this day.
Lat 36-44 Long 73-46

Sun. 21

This day begins with a moderate breeze from the N.E. Raised a school of whales lowered for them and got one brought. Then alongside and looked on to him. Finished cutting and started the works again. Spoke the S.S. Force of N.Y. Bound South. Lat 37-02 Long 72-15 So ends this day.

Mon. 22

This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. and squally. At 11 a.m. raised a school of whales going to windward. Did not give chase. Cdr. all employed in working on oil. So ends this day. Long 71-30

Tues 23

This day comes in with a light breeze from the North. Crew working on oil. Latter part the same. Saw E. B. Cornell. Lat 37-30 Long 72-16

Wed 24

This day comes in with a light breeze from the N. made sail and steered to the Westward. At 2 p.m. saw E. B. Cornell with per boat down and then raised whales lowered and got one and did not get alongside until 10 p.m. made him fast for the night. So ends this day. Lat 36-40 Long 73-55

Thurs. 25

This day comes in with it moderate. At 5 a.m. looked on to the whale and at 7 a.m. finished cutting and started the works again. Raised more whales lowered but did not get near them as there was no wind gave up chase and gained the E. B. Cornell, G. City in sight. So ends this day. Lat 36-45 Long 73-55

Fri. 26

This day comes in with a fresh breeze and squally. Crew working on oil. Gained the G. City. E. B. Cornell and H. Chase in sight. So ends this day. Lat 36-42

Sat. 27

This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. and rough. Three whales in sight. Latter part the same. So ends this day. Long 74-00

Sun. 28

This day comes in calm. At 6 a.m. raised a school of whales lowered for them and got two and then it breeze up light from the North and foggy. Crew alongside with whales and looked on to them. Finished cutting and set the works again. Gained E. B. Cornell. So ends this day. Lat 36-45 Long 74-05

Mon. 29

This day comes in with it calm and foggy. Saw the G. B. Cornell take a whale alongside. R. Bertha in sight. At 6 p.m. heard whales close by did not lower as it was thick of fog. Crew working on oil. Spoke this day. Gained alongside of the S. S. Furman of N.Y. Bound South.

Tues. 30

This day comes in with a breeze from the S.W. At 7 a.m. saw sports. At 8 a.m. saw Golden City take a whale. Did not give chase as whales were going quick to the Greenway. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. So ends this day. Lat 36-48 Long 73-49

Wed 31

This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. E. B. Cornell in sight. Latter part the same. At 6 p.m. spoke the Cornell. So ends this day. Lat 37-02 Long 74-08
