 saw Comell with boat down lowered
 our boats and went on and struck one
 came alongside and cut him in and
 started boiling.

Mon 17 This day fine weather. Raised whales
 lowered but did not get near them.
 Raised more whales in the afternoon lowered
 but did not get any. boiling.

Tue 18 Fresh S. S. W. wind and rough.
 working on oil.

Wed 19 Fresh S. S. W. wind and rough
 Comell in sight.

Thur. 20 S. S. W. squally heavy swell Comell
 and S. City in sight. Spoke a Savannah
 steamer.

Fri. 21 S. W. wind. Raised whales at 4 p.m.
 lowered and starboard struck and got stove
 starboard boat. both the whales and came
 alongside with him and made fast for
 the night.

Sat. 22 This day comes in fresh from the
 Eastward at 4 a.m. hooked on to the
 whale and finished cutting at 7 a.m.
 4 whales in sight squalls and rain put
 the fire out for the night.

Sun. 23 Day squally weather boiling wind
 Southly.

Mon. 24 This day comes in with a fresh
 breeze Southly. Set mainsail and
 kept off for home. Latter part weather
 fair.

Tue. 25 This day comes in with a good breeze
 from the S. W. reefed under all sail
 steering N. by E. 1/2 E. Crew doing
 various jobs about ship but - shant.
 Latter part the same.
