- July 2nd Mond. This day comes in with a fine breeze from the S. W. At 2 p.m. raised whale in the edge of the Gulf Stream lowered and got one came along side and cut him in. So ends this day.
- 3rd. Tues. This day comes in with a light breeze from the S. W. Biting and working on the whale. So ends this day.
- 4th. Wed. This day comes in with it raining and a breeze from the S. W. Working on oil taking part the same. So ends this day.
- 5th. Thurs. This day comes in with a breeze from the S. W. E. Raised whale lowered and got one came along side and cut him in and took in main sail. So ends this day.
- 6th. Fri. This day comes in with it raining and a fresh breeze from the E. W. E. vessel under two top sails and got stay sail and a number of vessels taking part the same. So ends this day.
- 7th. Sat. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the W. W. E. set the works going. Saw a number of steamers taking part. Good weather. So ends this day.
- 8th. Sun. This day comes in with a light breeze from the S. W. vessel steering to the North. Lowered and got one came along side and cut him in and made sail and steering to the E. of the ship. The ship. So ends this day.

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- Mon. 9. This day comes in with a light breeze. Crew employed in taking out and working on it. So ends this day.
- Tues. 10. This day comes in with a light breeze from the S. W. finished taking out and got one came along side and cut him in. So ends this day.
- Wed. 11. This day comes in with a light breeze. set the works going and at 3 p.m. finished taking out and set the fore sail and stayed. So ends this day.
- Thurs. 12. This day comes in with a light breeze from the W. E. set the fore sail and at 3 p.m. stayed up light from the S. W. So ends this day.
- Fri. 13. This day comes in with it thick of fog and light breeze from the W. E. at 3 p.m. under the land and at 7 p.m. saw Fire Island light and light. So ends this day.
- Sat. 14. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the W. E. vessel under lower sails heading in towards Shinnecock at 10 a.m. reefed the main sail and fore sail and at 2 p.m. moderated and took him out and made all sail and at 6 p.m. was abreast of Mantaunk Pt. So ends this day.
- Sun. 15. This day comes in moderate and wind W.
