May 9th. Then this day comes in with it foggy and a heavy swell from the S.W. vessel under short sail at 3 p.m. to wind hauls to the N. No observation so ends this day

" 10 Friday this day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. vessel under short sail and went to the Eastward at 3 p.m. saw a school of 13 fish went aboard and got me took in sail at sundown Lat. 38-07 Long. 72-14 so ends this day.

" 11 Sat. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. vessel under short sail at 1 p.m. wind hauled to the North and began up fresh vessel heading to the Westward saw 1 whale called Dead V. More moderate at night Long. 72-14 so ends this day.

" 12 Sunday this day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E. at 9 a.m. 0.0.0. the main sail and stood to the Westward got 3 surprises Latta part light breeze took in sail at sundown Lat. 37-40 Long. 73-26 so ends this day

" 13 Monday this day comes in with a light breeze from the Eastward made sail and stood to the Southward saw 4 vessels at 1 p.m. Latta part wind to the Southward light and puff took in sail Lat. 37-36 Long. 73-36 so ends this day

" 14 Tuesday this day comes in very moderate saw 1 whale boiling raised a school of whales lowered for them but they were going quick to boats came aboard Latta part calm so ends this day Lat. 37-44 Long. 74-47

May 15 Wed. This day begins with it calm at 11 a.m. heaved up light from the Southward Latta part the same so ends this day Lat. 38-00 Long. 74-14

16. Thurs. This day comes in moderate Latta part the same so ends this day Lat. 38-08 Long. 74-18

17. Friday this day comes in moderate & foggy Latta part the same so ends this day

18 Sat. This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. made sail & stood to the Westward at 6 p.m. saw 2 whales took in sail at sundown so ends this day 37-52 - 73-22

19 Sunday this day comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. and rough at 8 a.m. guarded the Bertha Ripper of West Bay and saw a number of porpoises at 5 p.m. spoke the O.K. Bertha of West Bay so ends this day 37-50 - 73-11

20 Monday this day comes in very moderate wind from the North and a swell from the South 2 whales in sight so ends this day 38-20 Long. 72-30

21 Tuesday this day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. West. P. Vernal B. Ripper E.W. Sniff B. Bertha in sight Latta part the same so ends this day Lat. 37-57 Long. 74-45

22 Wed. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.W. made sail and stood to the Westward in company with 2 coasters & the B. Ripper P. Vernal and the Ellen A. Sniff at 3 p.m. guarded the Swift Latta part calm took in sail so ends this day Lat. 37-56 Long. 74-54
