five round and hove to. Haul the forestay sail down. E. A. Swift in sight. At 8 P.M. moderate so end the day. Wind S.W.
no observation.

May 31. Sunday. This day comes in with a light breeze from the S. set sail. Schrs E. A. Swift in sight. At 12.30. A.M. bend on the jibtop sail. At 6.30. P.M. took in the mainsail and set the trisail so end the day.
Lat. 38.57. Long 72.05. Heard Whales in the night.

June 1. Monday. This day comes in with a light breeze and fog from the S.W. At 11.30. A.M. whales alongside. lowered 2 boats. the Starboard boat got one. Came alongside and cut him up. At 2.30. P.M. fog cleared off. Start to boil. at 6.30. P.M. took in the mainsail and set the trisail. So end the day.
Lat 38.40 Long 71.34.

" 2. Tuesday. This day comes in with a light breeze from the N. finish boiling at 5 A.M. set sail. Saw 2 Schrs cutting whales. and 1 Bark. Stowed down the oil. Unbend the forestay sail and jib and bend another on. At 7 P.M. took in the mainsail and set the trisail so end the day.
Lat 38.00. Long 72.00.

" 3 Wednesday. This day comes in with a light breeze from the W. set sail. Three Schrs and one Bark in sight. from the Bark Dertha. At 7 P.M. took in the mainsail and set the trisail. so end the day.
Lat 37.40. Long 71.01.

" 4 Thursday. This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.E. set sail. Schrs B. C. Nickerson in sight. The Nickerson raised whales. lowered her boats. We lowered our 3 boats. the Starboard boat got 2. whales. Came alongside and cut them up at 9.30 took in the mainsail and set the trisail. and got the works ready to boil. so end the day. Francis Deago. Refused duty.
Lat 37.50. Long 71.04

" 5. Friday. This day comes in calm. Nickerson in sight raised whales. lowered 2 boats. raised whales on our lee beam. lowered the Haist boat. at 10. A.M. a light breeze from the N.E. the Starboard boat struck one whale but lost it. Came alongside. boiling. so end the day.
Lat 38.10 Long 71.34.

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June 6. Saturday. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E. finish boiling. raised a school of whales. Lowered 3 boats. the Starboard boat got one. Came alongside and cut him in. Schrs E. A. Swift B. C. Nickerson and J. A. Monter in sight. raised whales on the lee. lowered 2 boats. the Starboard boat got one. Came alongside and made fast for the night. so end the day.
Lat 38.10. Long 71.52.

" 7 Sunday. This day comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. 3 Schrs in sight. Cut in the whale. As soon as we finish raised whales. lowered 2 boats got 2 whales. Came alongside and cut them in. At 3 P.M. Commence to boil. so end the day.
Lat 37.40. Long 71.01.

" 8. Monday. This day comes in with a light breeze from the E. still boiling. Three Schrs in sight. raised spouts to leeward. made sail. At 5 P.M. took in sail so end the day.
Lat 37.45. Long 72.37.

" 9 Tuesday. This day comes in with a light breeze from the E. set sail. Still boiling. Schrs E. A. Swift B. C. Nickerson. J. A. Monter and one Bark. in sight. at 7 P.M. took in sail set the trisail so end the day.
Lat 37.57. Long 72.55.

" 10 Wednesday. This day comes in calm. finish boiling at 1 A.M. Three Schrs in sight. stowed the oil below. At 8 A.M. a light breeze from the S.W. set sail wash the deck. take the sealing out the Starboard boat. paint and laid them back at 7 P.M. took in sail so end the day.
Lat 38.02. Long 73.06.

" 11 Thursday. This day comes in with a light breeze from the North and drizzling rain. set sail at 7 A.M. took in the mainsail at 3.30 P.M. took in the foresail fresh breeze. At 7 P.M. unbend the jibtop sail so end the day.
Lat 38.00. Long 72.59.
