

Journal Continued.

June 12 Friday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. Set sail. Paint the boats. Gave the g. R. Monitor. At 6 P.M. took in the sails so end the day.
Lat 38.05. Long 72.06.

" 13 Saturday This day Comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. Set sail. g. R. Monitor in sight. Fire the tryworks, the Starboard boat Puddah and Water day boarded the four masted Schr. Lucinda Sutton of Boston. At 7 P.M. took in sail so end the day.
Lat 38.15. Long 72.10.

" 14 Sunday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. Set sail. (Schr. g. R. Monitor in sight) and steered to the Southward. At 7 A.M. Antone Cobral, seaman. Came to the galley for his breakfast with a heavy club to strike the Cook. Thomas M. Lean. The Captain asked him for the club and he drew off to strike him with it. The mates started to put him in irons and all of the crew forward began to show fight with clubs. They had stowed away. And said if any man from aft came forward they would strike them to kill. Kept off and steared north bound home on account of mutiny forward so ends this day.
Lat 38.25. Long 72.01.

" 15 Monday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. All sail set steering N.E. by N. raised a school of Blackfish. lowered three boats the waistboat got 2. Starboard boat lost one. Came alongside cut their heads off and boil them. Wash the ship. fix the anchors stows and haul the chain out the hole. so end the day.
Lat 39.43 Long 71.37.

" 16 Tuesday. This day Comes in with a light breeze and rain from the S.W. At 6.30 A.M. the wind shifted N.W. fresh. Haul down the mainsail jib topsail and flying jib set the trisail. At 8.30 moderate set the mainsail. At 11 A.M. turn back, Coast S. by W. with all sails set. Stowed away the chains. so end the day.
Lat 40.40. Long 71.16.

" 17 Wednesday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. All sail set. Saw four Schrs one Steamer and a small boat bound north. At 6.30 P.M. took in sail set the trisail so end this day.
Lat 38.27. Long 70.53.

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June 18 Thursday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. Set sail. At 11.45 A.M. raised a school of Whales. lowered three boats the starboard boat got one. Came alongside and cut him up. Saw 2 steamers. At 7 P.M. took in sail and prepare the works to boil. so end this day.
Lat 37.45 Long 72.22.

" 19 Friday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. raised a school of whales (boiling) lowered three boats Starboard boat got one Came alongside and cut him up. At 4 P.M. took in the mainsail and set the trisail. So end this day.
Lat 37.35. Long 72.49.

" 20 Saturday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. still boiling. Set the mainsail. Wind increase to a fresh breeze. Set up the Starboard main rigging. At 2 P.M. finish boiling. At 4 P.M. set the foresail. Stowed a part of the oil. At 7 P.M. took in the mainsail so end this day.
Lat 37.32. Long 72.39.

" 21 Sunday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. raised a school of whales. Lowered three boats. The Starboard boat got two. the Waistboat lost one. Came alongside and cut them up. Saw three Steamers and one Schr. At 7 P.M. took in sail and prepare the works to boil so end this day.
Lat 37.30. Long 73.03.

" 22 Monday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the N. boiling. raised whales. Lowered two boats the Starboard boat got one. Came alongside, stop boiling cut him up and made fast the head alongside for the night. Schr. E.A. Swift gained us. so end this day.
Lat 37.35. Long 72.52.

" 23 Tuesday. This day Comes in with a light breeze from the S.S.W. took in the head and Commence to boil. Schr. E.A. Swift in sight. Schr. B.D. Dickerson gained us. at 6.30 P.M. set the fore trisail took in the mainsail and set the trisail so end this day.
Lat 37.31. Long 72.46.
