

## Journal Continued

June 24. Wednesday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. still boiling. B.D. Dickerson in sight. At 6.30 A.M. set the mainsail. At 4 P.M. took in the mainsail set the maintrussail so end this day.  
Lat 37.46. Long 73.24.

" 25 Thursday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. set the mainsail. At 1 P.M. finished boiling. At 3.30 P.M. B.D. Dickerson raised a school of whales and lowered his boats. He lowered two boats also E.A. Swift. We never got any. Came alongside took in the mainsail and stowed part of the oil so end this day.  
Lat 37.40. Long = =

" 26 Friday: This day comes in with a light breeze and rain from the E. Sehr B.D. Dickerson and E.A. Swift in sight. finish stowing oil. Wind increased to a fresh breeze. At 4 P.M. reef the foresail so end this day.  
Lat 37.30. Long 73.44.

" 27 Saturday: This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the E.N.E. maintrussail and foresail set. Steaming E. by S. At 7 A.M. the mate went forward to reef the foresail and all the men with the exception of John Tiera refused to work. The men from aft reef the foresail and work the ship all day. At 8 P.M. the men still not working set the watches so end this day.  
Lat 36.53. Long 73.39.

" 28 Sunday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the N.W. E. all sails set. raised a school of whales. The men all went on duty lowered three boats. whales passed by. raised another school of whales lowered two boats they passed by. Three Sehr in sight. took in the mainsail so end this day.  
Lat 36.58. Long 73.10.

" 29 Monday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. raised a school of whales lowered three boats. got two Starboard and Waistboat. Came alongside and made fast for the night. Sehr Came and B.D. Dickerson in sight so ends this day.

June 30. Tuesday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. All the crew to work. Cut up both whales. raised a school of whales lowered three boats got three whales. Starboard boat two Starboard boat one. Came alongside and cut them up and start the works going took in the mainsail so end this day.  
Lat - - Long 72.05.

July 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. boiling. raised a school of whales. lowered two boats whales went by. At 11.30 A.M. raised another school of whales lowered two boats got two whales. Starboard boat one. Starboard boat one. Came alongside and cut them up. took in the mainsail so end this day.  
Lat 38.15. Long 71.11.

" 2 Thursday: This day comes in Calm. Still boiling. at 12.30 P.M. Light breeze from the S.W. Sehr Carleton Bell gamed us. spoke the steamer Aere so end this day.  
Lat 38.31. Long 71.01.

" 3 Friday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the N.W. set all sails. still boiling. Sehr C. Bell in sight. took in the mainsail at 6 P.M. so end this day.  
Lat 38.43. Long 71.18. Francis Diego refused to obey the Capt. and told him that he had no boss over him aboard of this vessel.

" 4 Saturday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S. all sails set. finish boiling. stowed down the oil. at 4.30 P.M. raised a school of whales lowered two boats. got two whales. The mate got his leg injured by the whale striking the boat and threw him overboard. lowered the Waistboat and went to assist him. Came alongside and made fast for the night. so end this day.  
Lat 38.36. Long 70.47.

" 5 Sunday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S. Cut in both whales and kept off for home. start the works agoing. so end this day.  
Lat 38.37. Long 70.27.

" 6 Monday: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. finish boiling. stowed part of the oil. drag the ship and put the main anchor chains on. sighted Block Island at 4.30 P.M. spoke the sloop Anona. so end this day. Lat 40.41. Long 71.03.
